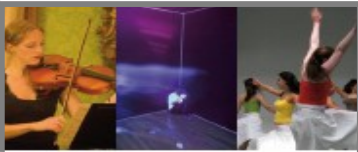

The New Year has also seen the DLRCC Arts Office launch of DLR ARTS general information booklet. Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council is committed to high quality arts and culture programming and since 1994 has commissioned and developed an exciting range of festivals, exhibi-

tions, performances and initiatives including the Festival Of World Cultures, the DLR Poetry Now Festival, the Irish Youth Dance Festival, the Concourse Visual Arts Exhibition Programme, the Artist Residency Programme, the Artist In Schools Programme, the Public Art Programme and the Country House Concert Series.

Carolyn Brown, Acting Arts Officer, explains, "Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has an ongoing vibrant arts programme and is currently in the process of selecting a number of residencies and other projects under a major per cent for art programme 'Place and Identity' which will take place from 2008-2010 and in excess of €500,000 from per cent for art funding has been allocated to it".

Artwork lights up Dalkey Older Persons Unit

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and the H.S.E. are delighted to announce the relocation of the artwork 'Saoi' by artist Séamus Kennedy to Dalkey Community Unit for Older Persons. The artwork was celebrated at a reception on the 23rd January with the Cathaoirleach, Councillor Denis O'Callaghan.

The artwork was originally sited near the sea at Newtownsmith in March 2006. It was created under a Department of Environment, Heritage and Local Government per cent for art scheme. The artwork consists of 3 boulders made from fibreglass which look like boulders by day; however, as dusk approaches and throughout the night, they become alive and communicate information through illuminated text; at intervals,

each boulder flashes with colour. The relocation of the artwork is a collaboration between a number of departments in the County Council (the Arts Office, Public Lighting and Parks) and the Dalkey Unit.

The Dalkey Community Unit for Older Persons opened in 2000. It provides care to older people in the local community. According to Triona McMorrow, Assistant Director of Nursing, The Unit hopes the Lumens project, Saoi, will have an uplifting effect on everyone, including both residents and staff. There is evidence to support the fact that involvement in the arts leads to less illness and improved wellbeing.

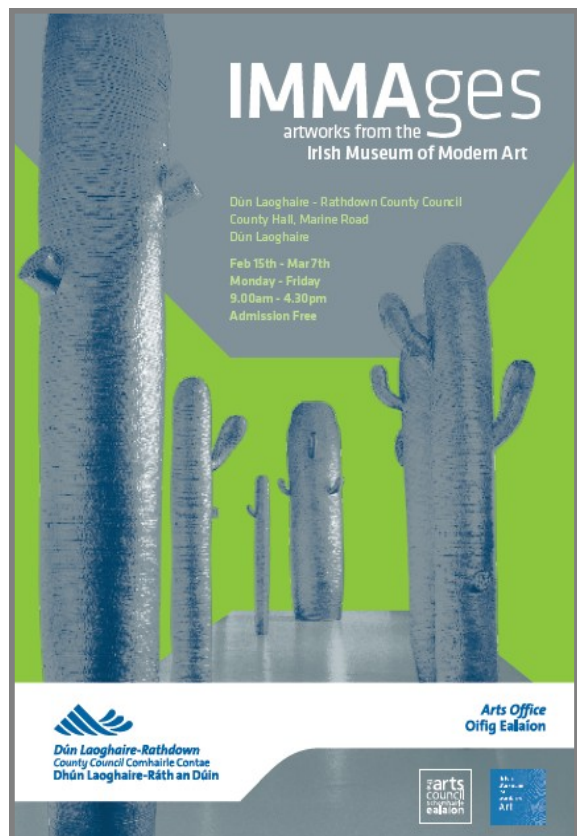
IMMAges Artworks from the Irish Museum of Modern Art Curated by staff and a councillor of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council

The artworks in IMMAges have been chosen by a team of ten staff and a County Councillor of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council from the collection of IMMA (Irish Museum of Modern Art). The team who are from various different departments in the County Council have worked on IMMAges for the past six months becoming involved in all aspects of exhibition management from curation, to technical requirements to marketing.

IMMA's National Programme allows organisations around the country such as Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council an opportunity to borrow and exhibit artworks from IMMA's superb collection of modern and contemporary art. However The National Programme does a lot more than that, it gives members of the host organisation a chance to learn about IMMA's collection and to see images of artworks that are not currently on view to the public. Most of



all, it gives people who don't normally work in the arts an opportunity to experience the challenges, the joy and the satisfaction of curating and organising an exhibition.

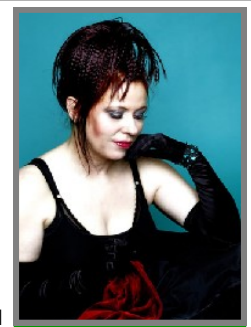

The primary purpose of this award is to support professional artists in developing their arts practice. Specifically, it can be used to 'buy time' and provide artists with the space, equipment, facilities and freedom to concentrate on their practice.

While the emphasis is on time and space for research, thinking and development of the applicant's art practice, the scheme also allows for costs associated with the production and or dissemination of work.

The maximum Bursary Award available is €15,000 per year per artist. In a limited number of cases the Arts Council will also support applications for multi-annual bursaries of up to €30,000 for a two-year period or €45,000 for a three-year period.
