Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council is delighted to present a video by artist Patricia McKenna based on a temporary artwork which she created on Sandycove Beach in September. The video will show in the Institute of Art, Design & Technology (IADT, in the Trevor Scott Hall), Kill Avenue, Dún Laoghaire between 11:00 am and 4:00 pm on Saturday 8th November. Admission is free and all are welcome.

For the artwork, Patricia created brightly coloured gelatine pieces, loosely based on fish and other forms, that were placed on the beach at low tide. They gradually dissolved and drifted out to sea, leaving no trace of the work. Patricia is concerned with the idea of time and how we cannot hold it or stop things from changing or moving on.

Patricia McKenna was born in Dublin and studied at the National College of Art and Design. She works in multi-media and site-specific installation. She has exhibited widely in Ireland, England, the USA and Europe and has been awarded a number of Arts Council travel grants and awards. Patricia currently lives in Monkstown, Co. Dublin.



Seachange

Seachange is part of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council's Place and Identity programme of Per Cent for Art commissions funded through the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government. Six residencies and three once-off projects will take place over the life of the programme. It encompasses a range of artforms, including theatre, music, dance, visual art and literature; will cover the entire county and will involve local people as both participants and audience.

Kilkenny County Councils Arts Office and Library Service have a strong commitment to providing literary developments through partnership between the Arts Office and Library Service. We also focus on ensuring a balanced approach to the development of projects and activities across all art forms within Kilkenny city and county. Therefore we are now seeking applications to appoint a writer in residence.

Writers are invited to make applications focussing their applications on the ability of the residency to develop and generate new audiences for the libraries and for the writing community of Kilkenny. We expect that the residency will extend the appreciation of writing and literature and enhance accessibility to this art form. We also anticipate that it will introduce Kilkenny based writers to new experiences and offer new opportunities. This project is also part of Kilkenny County Councils Art Office's programme support the continuing professional development of practitioners in Kilkenny.

A comprehensive survey early in 2008 identified a number of areas and issues that our literary community wish to be addressed. Applicants must give details on how they would approach and address these issues within their application for the position. This is contained in the application and supporting information details available from the Arts Office.

Deadline for receipt of applications is no later than 4pm Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2008.

Local artist wanted to produce a game that encourages children aged between 5 and 11 (although all kids generally want to play even the big kids know commonly as parents) to throw beanbags into one of four receptacles.

Illustrations painted onto the beanbags will represent common materials that might be disposed of at home, e.g. a glass bottle, cooked food, paper, cans, batteries etc. The receptacles represent common disposal options - a compost bin, a green recycling bin and black refuse bin and a recycling centre. The challenge for the children is to decide the best environmental option when disposing of different waste materials. Ideally all the props should be made from recycled material.

The beanbags need to be machine washable, ideally filled with an inert material (I used old buttons as a filler). The receptacles have to be easily identifiable, easily transported, sturdy and of a size that offers a reasonable challenge to youngsters when throwing the beanbags from 5-10 yards.
