The festival will also host writing workshops, a children's reading, the announcement and presentation of **The Irish Times Poetry Now Award 2008** for best collection of poetry in 2007 and the **Strong Award For Best First Collection in 2007**, and our kick-off includes a rousing panel discussion on the question of poetry itself, where it's read and why it's needed. We hope to have your company at the readings, talks and events.


