Did you know that DLR Arts runs a diverse range of community and educational programmes and projects?

In partnership with support organisations and agencies, DLR Arts works on a range of community and educational programmes to ensure that high quality sustainable arts programming is supported around the county.

Our Arts and Health Programme, in partnership with the HSE takes place in Dalkey Community Unit for Older Persons, Coisceim Residential Unit and St. Joseph's House for Adult Deaf and Blind and includes

- Ballroom Dancing Project that links with local active retirement groups as well as our arts and health centres and hosts an old style tea party complete with an over 50's show band as well as weekly dance workshops throughout the summer months.
- Quilting Project, "Material Memories", will be unveiled at this year's Festival of World Cultures.
- Killiney Tea Rooms Reminiscence Project with curator Claire Behan.

Our Primary Schools Programme, in partnership with Blackrock Education Centre, works with over 30 primary schools per year. This programme places artists in schools around the county working directly with the schoolchildren and their teachers, and links with DLR Poetry Now Festival and the Children's International Theatre Festival.

Our Youth Arts Programme, in partnership with DLR Community Development Section and local youth service providers, has initiated several new opportunities for the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown community such as:

1. The Grainstore Youth Arts Facility, complete with band rehearsal space, multipurpose hall, visual arts room and tuition room. For rentals and bookings contact lauralarkin@dlrcoco.ie.

As the evening approaches the participants literally watch the installation 'grow'. However, when the evening has set in and everyone has gone home and the park closes for the night, the poppies illuminate, secretly transforming the park's space within the darkness.
