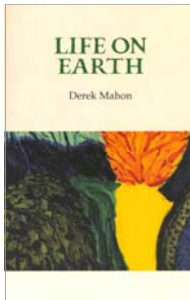




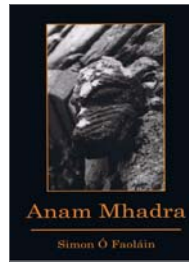
DLR Poetry Now 2009 Festival Highlights And Award Winners Announced

DLR Poetry Now 2009 took place in the Pavilion Theatre from Thursday 26th to Sunday 29th of March. The festival kicked off with an interesting and informative keynote address by Pulitzer Prize nominee and three times Poet Laureate of the United States, Robert Pinsky.



The festival hosted a number of readings by participants from as far as Belarus, India and Slovenia as well as those by distinguished Irish poets including Harry Clifton and Paddy Bushe. Derek Mahon received the prestigious Irish Times Poetry Now Award for best Irish collection of 2008 for Life on Earth from Gallery Books while Simon Ó Faoláin was awarded the Rupert and Eithne Strong Award for best Irish first collection of 2008.

The highlight of the festival was a very special 70th Birthday Tribute for Seamus Heaney, long time friend of DLR Poetry Now. Presented by broadcaster John Kelly the 17 poets of DLR Poetry Now 2009 read poems by Seamus Heaney as the Nobel prize-winner sat in the front row. DLR Poetry Now

presented Seamus Heaney with a beautiful artwork by renowned Irish artist Hughie O'Donoghue. The event culminated with Seamus Heaney reading three of his poems finishing with In The Attic, a poem printed on a signed broadsheet that was handed out to all in the audience.





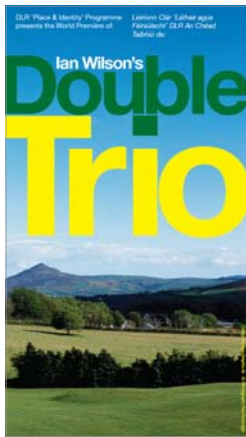

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council is delighted to present Double Trio, a new work by composer Ian Wilson.

Double Trio was written during the summer and autumn of 2008 as the main focus of a one-year residency in the Glencullen area of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County. Double Trio is written for three improvisers – playing saxophone, double bass and drums – and three classical musicians – playing violin, vibraphone and harp – and takes its initial inspiration from speech rhythms and melodies. The musicians are Cathal Roche, saxophonist, Daniel Bodwell, bass and Stu Ritchie, drums alongside Mia Cooper, violin, Cliona Doris, harp and Richard O'Donnell, vibraphone. Double Trio lasts approximately 45 minutes and is in eight main sections.

Double Trio is part of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council's 'Place and Identity' programme of Per Cent for Art commissions funded through the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government.

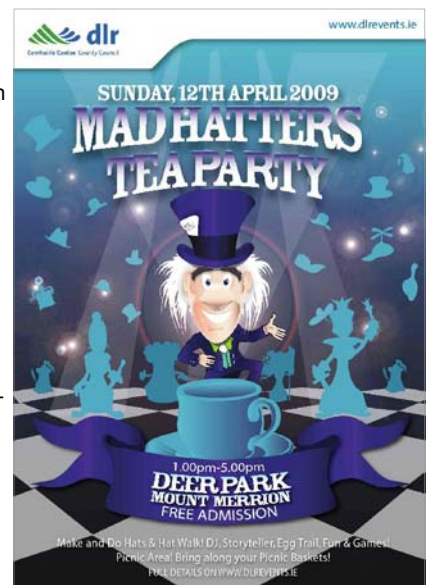

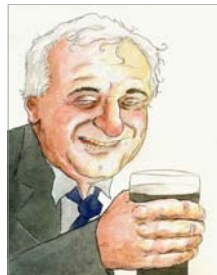
