DLR Arts and Airfield have announced that London based artist Andrew Dodds is the recipient of the Airfield Residency 2009.

Drawing upon Airfield's rich archive, and mixing fact and fiction, Dodds will be creating an immersive 'social sculpture' within Airfield's grounds. Through the artwork Andrew will be teasing out links between our cultural and 'natural' histories with a specific focus on Airfield's recent past. The immersive sculpture and a series of participatory public events will take place between 22 - 31 July.

Andrew Dodds is a Belfast-born artist, now based in London. His work is usually made for a particular place or time and incorporates a wide range of artistic methods and media including installation, sculpture, sound, video and talking birds. His practice is concerned with uncovering the social and political resonances often hidden within landscape representation. He has a Masters in Fine Art from London's prestigious Slade School of Fine Art and his work has been commissioned and exhibited widely at major public galleries, artist-run spaces and sites beyond the gallery.

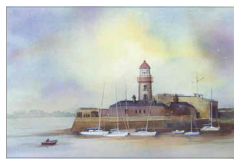

The maximum Bursary Award available is €15,000 per year per artist, though in a limited number of cases the Arts Council will also support applications for multi-annual bursaries of up to €30,000 for a 2 year period or €45,000 for a 3 year period.
