PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF IDRONE TERRACE, BLACKROCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Irish Rail that proposes the temporary closure of part of Idrone Terrace, Blackrock from No.1 Idrone Terrace to No.5 Idrone Terrace on **Saturday, 14th October 2023** between 06:00 hours and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is maintenance to railway infrastructure.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GEORGE'S STREET LOWER, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Cumnor Building & Civil Engineering Contractors Ltd. to temporarily close George's Street Lower, Dún Laoghaire from its junction at Library Road to its junction at Sussex Street. The closure will run from Thursday, 28th September 2023 to Wednesday, 4th October 2023.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is <u>resurfacing road outside St. Michael's Hospital</u> as part of final phase of Myrtle Square and Convent Lane Greening Project.

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2023 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 18/09/2023 until 30/11/2023

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

 Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound.

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 60 km/hr and 60 km on the N11 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Roads Traffic Act, 2004.

Accordingly, I recommend the introduction of the 60 km/hr speed limit (N11 Southbound and Northbound) from Monday 18th September 2023 until Thursday 30th November 2023 or for the duration of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Thornhill Road / Old Connaught Avenue junction to Allies River Road junction from **Monday, 11th September 2023** to **Friday, 17th November 2023**. Closure will commence when the works on Thornhill Road have been completed.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is <u>installation of Ferndale Road culvert replacement</u> for Uisce Éireann.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kilternan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane until **Friday**, **24**th **November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the <u>watermains works</u> on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd to temporarily close Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 3rd July 2023** to **Thursday, 29th February 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic.

The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other division routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is <u>full road reconstruction works</u> will require the road to be excavated with associated ancillary works on the footpath.

» Woodbrook Shanganagh Wastewater Network Extension Works (UISCE ÉIREANN) ***

Wastewater system improvement works are being carried out by GMC on behalf of Uisce Éireann in Shanganagh Cliffs, Corbawn Avenue, Corbawn Drive, Quinn's Road and Shanganah Park.

» Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme ***

On September 11th Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, will commence works to provide a two-way cycle track on the western side of Deansgrange Road. The works will also upgrade pedestrian and cyclist's facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road.

Some localised Stop/Go traffic management will be in operation between the hours of 10am and 4pm from September 11th to September 15th.

From Monday, September 18th, there will be no northbound access to Deansgrange Road from Clonkeen Road / Kill Lane for approximately six months. Southbound access will remain open via a new temporary one-way system south of St. Fintan's Villas. Diversion signs will be in place.

The 84 and 84A northbound bus services will be diverted via Abbey Road for the duration of the works. The southbound bus route remains the same.
