COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. The competition is open to primary school students in the Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council area.
- 2. The competition will be judged in the following categories:
 - Class Category Junior Infants and Senior Infants
 - Class Category First Class and Second Class
 - Class Category Third Class and Fourth Class
 - Class Category Fifth Class and Sixth Class
- 3. The design of the poster shall focus on the theme 'Cycling and Safety'.
 - 4. Posters should be created with crayons, pencils, markers, paint, ink or collage materials.
 - 5. Each student shall submit one entry only. Each entry must clearly state the school name, student name, age, class, a parents contact number and also the school contact details. These details will be kept confidential. A parent, guardian or teacher must also sign that the artwork is original.
 - 6. Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council may use some of the posters from the prize giving event in future events promoting Cycling and Road Safety in Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council.
 - 7. A panel of <u>judges from DLR</u> will choose the winning entry in each category. This decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
 - 8. Entries will not be returned.
 - 9. The winners and their class will by notified in early June with the prize giving taking place on Friday June 16th, 2017.
