Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown Joint Policing Committee

Meeting Report Tuesday, 24th May 2022, The Talbot Hotel, Stillorgan, Co. Dublin

The Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown Joint Policing Committee meeting took place in The Talbot Hotel, Stillorgan on the 24th May 2022 at 6.00 p.m.

Below is a synopsis of the meeting:

- The Chair welcomed the members to the meeting and apologies were noted.
- The minutes of the JPC meeting on the 15th February 2022 were approved.
- Gerry Flaherty, Senior Executive Engineer, Traffic and Road Safety Section, gave a
 brief presentation on road collision data from the RSA. It was noted that there were
 3 fatal collisions in recent months in the County and a summary of the fatal collisions
 was outlined. It was also noted that work has commenced on the preparation of a
 new Road Safety Plan 2022 to 2030 and the Council is seeking feedback from
 individuals, groups and key agencies on what actions should be contained in the
 Road Safety Plan.
- Ian Smalley presented headline items from the reports of the Central Dún Laoghaire LPF, Ballybrack/Loughlinstown/Shankill LPF, Sandyford/Stepaside LPF and Dundrum/Stillorgan LPF. This was followed by a discussion and queries were responded to.
- Mary Ruane presented the JPC workplan updates.
- Chief Superintendent Nyland gave a presentation which included the following areas:
 - Outline of Garda Victim Support Service
 - Outline of Divisional Protective Services Unit
 - Operation Irene 2022
 - o DMR East Divisional Drugs statistics (1st January- 20th May 2022)
 - Breakdown of Crime Statistics April 2021/2022
 - Breakdown of Roads Policing Statistics January April 2020-2022 (comparison year on year)

Following a discussion, Chief Superintendent Nyland responded to the queries raised and the committee thanked him for the report and for the work of An Garda Síochána.
