Workshops

Architecture in drawings

Mixed Leaves Study Ida Mitrani

Botanical art workshops

Wednesday 20 and 27 April: 6.15–8.15pm — Project Room

Suitable for beginners, participants must be available for both dates.

These two workshops with artist Ida Mitrani are designed as an introduction to botanical illustration. Using graphite pencils and watercolour paint, learn how to measure and portray plants. The workshops will cover line drawing, shading and some watercolour techniques. There will also be an emphasis on colour theory.
