Learn to create three-dimensional, sculptural works using traditional and contemporary techniques of hand paper making with artist Tunde Toth. Pure plant fibres and recycled paper materials will be sculpted and moulded into small shapes, coloured with fabric dyes. The workshop also introduces a contemporary silk fibre paper making process using raw silk and fabric dyes.
