

Leopardstown Link Road & Roundabout Reconfiguration Scheme

Temporary Arrangements for Pedestrians & Cyclists

Between 10:00am and noon on Tuesday 2nd February 2016 the existing roundabout will be removed and replaced with a signalised junction. Unfortunately the permanent pedestrian & cycle facilities for the new junction will not be in place at this time. This work will take a further 6 weeks approximately to complete.

PEDESTRIANS

To facilitate these works the pedestrian crossing, on Leopardstown Road West between the roundabout and the junction with the new link road, will be removed. Pedestrians will be asked to utilize the two crossings shown on the sketch overleaf. Alternatively it may be more convenient for pedestrians coming from Leopardstown Road West or South County Business Park to access Sandyford Business District via Burton Hall Link Road.

CYCLISTS

While cyclists may continue to travel on the road it should be noted that the two banned vehicular right turn movements listed below will also apply to cyclists:

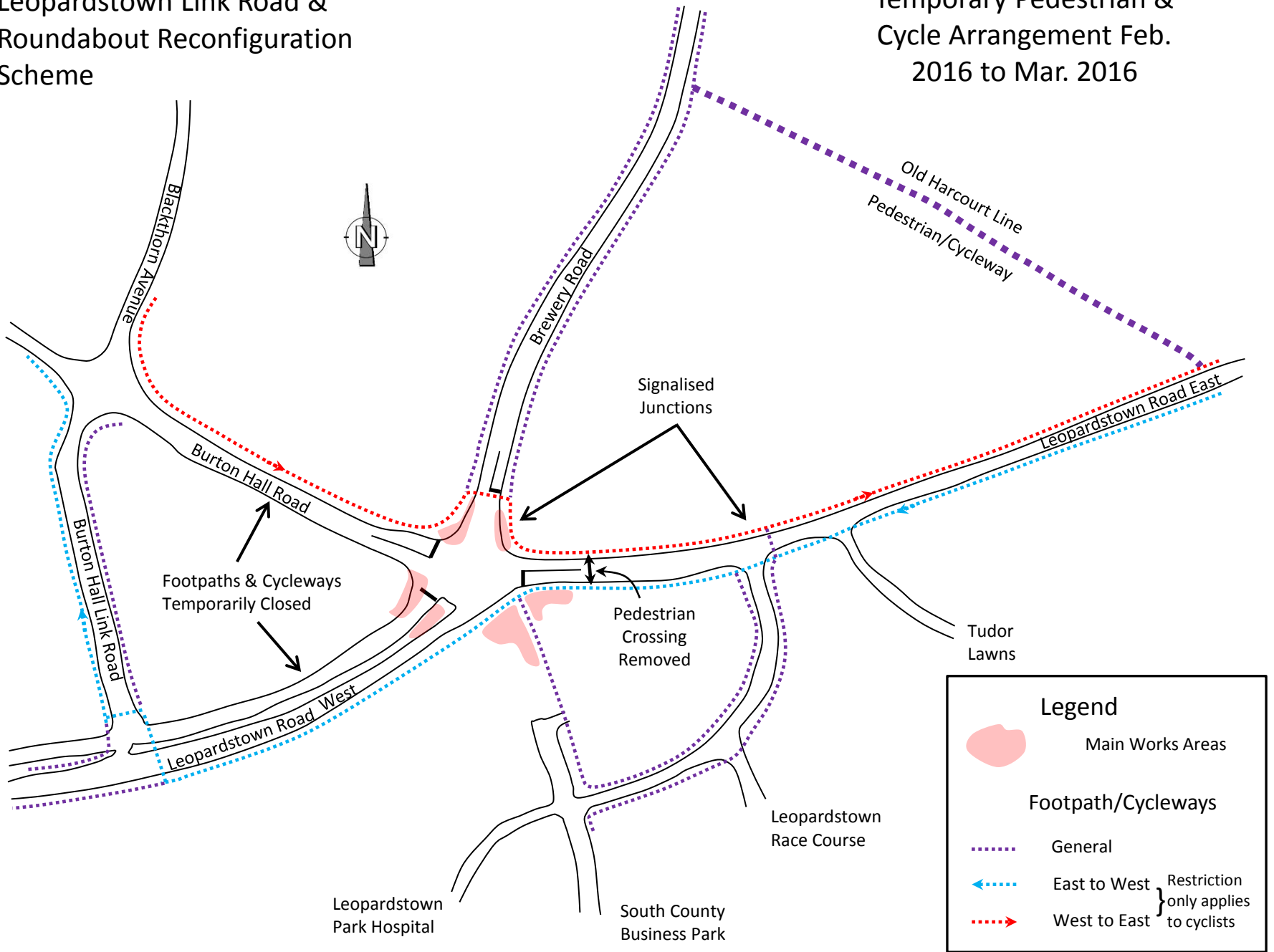
Leopardstown Road East to Brewery Road

Sandyford Business District to Leopardstown Road West

Cyclists coming from the N11 destined for Sandyford Business District are asked to do so via Burton Hall Link Road. Cyclists travelling in the opposite direction should travel via Burton Hall Road and cross Brewery Road to Leopardstown Road East
