

DLR'S COVID-19 RESPONSE: DUNDRUM MOBILITY INTERVENTIONS

Commencing **Monday August 10th**, the Council is implementing a new **One-Way Traffic System for Dundrum village**. This will provide a calmed traffic environment and more space for pedestrians & cyclists while also facilitating public amenity improvements. A broad outline of the Interventions is set out below followed by details of the required **Diversions** to **Bus Services** and **Traffic**, which also commence from **Monday August 10th**.


New One-Way Traffic Layout




New Segregated Cycle Lanes




Existing Cycle Lanes





















Travelling towards Enniskerry & Glencullen





Travelling towards City & DCU (No Change)

New Bus Stop













To Sandyford Road and Kilmacud Road Upper




