PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993
Temporary Closure of Glasthule Road, Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Seatang Ltd, 59 Glasthule Road, Glasthule, Co. Dublin for the temporary closure of **Glasthule Road** from the junction of Link Road and Adelaide Road to Elton Park junction on **Sunday 16th June**, **2019** from **7.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m.**

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the **Bloomsday Festival 2019.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted. Proposed diversion routes are via Sandycove Avenue West, Otranto Place, Marine Parade (R831) and Link Road.

Orwell Wheelers has requested the temporary closure of **Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer.** The closure is to take place from **6.30 p.m. – 9.30 p.m.** on **Wednesday 26th June, 2019**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Stephen Roche Cycle Race.**

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993Temporary Closure of Main Street, Dundrum

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council is proposing to close **Main Street, Dundrum** between its junctions with Upper Kilmacud Road to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **1.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.** on **Sunday 30th June, 2019.**

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Local access will be maintained at all times.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of R138 Stillorgan Road

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close R138/Stillorgan Road from Fosters Avenue to Belfield Bridge on Sunday 2nd June, 2019 from 13.30 p.m. to 16.30 p.m. in order to facilitate the running of the Flora Women's Mini Marathon. The proposed diversion route is via Foster's Avenue and Roebuck Road.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and the diversion route will be signposted.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Castle Street** from Allied Irish Bank to The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey on **Saturday 15th June, 2019 and Sunday 16th June, 2019** from **11a.m. to 7.00 p.m.** in order to promote **Dalkey Book Festival**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the street festival run in conjunction with Dalkey Book Festival and to bring a festival atmosphere for community and visitors.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» N31 – from its Junction with Royal Marine Road to its Junction with Newtown Avenue **

Cleansing and CCTV survey of gullies on N31 (part of) will continue week commencing on Monday, 3rd June 2019 until Friday, 7th June 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» N11 - outside Stillorgan Park Hotel **

To facilitate an ESB connection the bus lane will be closed from Mount Merrion Avenue to Stillorgan Park hotel on Tuesday, 4th June and Wednesday, 5th June 2019 between 19:00 and 23:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Heather Drive and Manor Heath, Ballinteer *

Footpath repair works will commence on Wednesday, 5th June 2019 and continue until Friday, 21st June 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Silchester Road at Silchester Downs, Glenageary *

Filming on location will take place on Sunday, 2nd June and Monday, 3rd June 2019 between 07:30 and 19:30 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for each phase of the works. Works will commence at the White's cross junction, i.e. Stillorgan Road (N11), Leopardstown Road and Newtownpark Avenue junction. Lane restrictions will apply during the works for each phase of the works.

Castlebrook, Dundrum *

Footpath repair works will continue until Friday, 7th June 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace - Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **June**, pier bench and skin wall construction will be progressed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the lower level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea wall and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of south bound bus lane) ***

Closure of south bound bus lane and restrictions on cycle lane will commence on Tuesday 30^{th} April between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs. to facilitate road widening works north of Circle K filing station on east side of N11. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion end of July 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Clonskeagh Road *** from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road will commence on Monday, 4th March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place <u>until end of June 2019</u> with lane closures between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane - north bound carriageway only) ***

Works will commence on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until autumn 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 – Outbound Carrigeway - Stillorgan Park Avenue Junction to Mount Merrion Junction **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns will commence on Monday, 8th April 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 (intermittent).

Working hours 10:00 – 16:00 and 19:30 – Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

N11 – Inbound Carriageway between – Junction Kilmacud Road Lower and Mount Merrion Junction **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns will commence on Monday, 8th April 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 (intermittent).

Working hours 10:00 - 16:00 and 19:30 - Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Deansgrange Road
- 3. Blackthorn Drive
- 4. Brewery Road.
- 5. Clonskeagh Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road,
- 9. Brennanstown Road.
- 10. Sandyford Business Park.

These works will continue until Friday, 30th August 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
