PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**
Temporary Road Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application to temporarily close **Castle Street** from The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey to Allied Irish Bank on **Monday 5th August, 2019** from **12 Noon to 6.00 p.m.** in order to facilitate **Dalkey Vintage Festival**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate safe parking and display of vintage cars as part of Dalkey Vintage Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

Bingo Loco Event Dún Laoghaire

Dún-Laoghaire / Rathdown Council are proposing to temporarily close 200m of **Harbour Road** on **Saturday 13th July, 2019** between **12noon and 11.30pm** in order to facilitate the **Bingo Loco Event** in the former Stena compound.

The section of Harbour Road will be closed from the junction at the Marine Road roundabout 200m west to the junction at the Marina.

A Traffic Management will be in place and diversions will be signposted.

ROAD CLOSURES

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**
Temporary Closure of Meadow Mount and
Section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer.** The closure is to take place from **6.30 p.m. – 9.30 p.m.** on **Wednesday 26th June, 2019.**

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Stephen Roche Cycle Race.**

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

Temporary Closure of Main Street, Dundrum

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Main Street, Dundrum** between its junctions with Upper Kilmacud Road to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **1.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.** on **Sunday 30th June, 2019.**

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Local access will be maintained at all times.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Green Route (Parallel to M50 North Bound Slow Lane) Ballinteer *****
(Night works)

Road repair works will commence on Wednesday, 26th June until Friday, 28th June 2019 between 20:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation. Lane restrictions in operation (this Road is a 2 Lane Dual Carriageway).

» **Brennanstown Road / Glenamuck Road North ***
(Night works)

Resurfacing works will commence on Monday, 24th June 2019 until Thursday, 27th June 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and night works between 18:00 and 00:00 Mon-Tue.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Seapoint Avenue, Blackrock ****
(Night works)

Cleaning and CCTV of sewer will be carried out on Monday, 24th June 2019 until Friday, 28th June 2019 from 19:00 until 07:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Monkstown Road, Monkstown ****

Inspection of carriageway ironworks will commence on Monday, 24th June 2019 until Friday, 28th June 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Semi Static Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Queen's Road, Monkstown ****

Minor footpath repairs will commence on Monday, 24th June 2019 until Friday, 28th June 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Brighton Avenue, Monkstown ****

Minor footpath repairs will commence on Monday, 24th June 2019 until Friday, 28th June 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **R116 – Rathmichael Road, Ballycorus Road, Brides Glen, Mullinastill Road and Stonebridge Road ****

Cleansing Department will be carrying out essential pavement and road maintenance on Tuesday, 25th June 2019 until Friday, 28th June 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for each phase of the works. Phase 2 of works will take place on N31 (Leopardstown Road). Traffic lane restrictions or footway /cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **June**, pier bench and skin wall construction will be progressed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the lower level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea wall and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of south bound bus lane) ***

Closure of south bound bus lane and restrictions on cycle lane will commence on Tuesday 30th April between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs. to facilitate road widening works north of Circle K filling station on east side of N11. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion end of July 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Clonskeagh Road *
from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road**

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road will commence on Monday, 4th March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place until end of June 2019 with lane closures between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane – north bound carriageway only) ***

Works will commence on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until autumn 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 – Outbound Carrigeway - Stillorgan Park Avenue Junction to Mount Merrion Junction **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns will commence on Monday, 8th April 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 (intermittent).

Working hours 10:00 – 16:00 and 19:30 – Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

N11 – Inbound Carriageway between – Junction Kilmacud Road Lower and Mount Merrion Junction **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns will commence on Monday, 8th April 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 (intermittent).

Working hours 10:00 – 16:00 and 19:30 – Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Deansgrange Road
3. Blackthorn Drive
4. Brewery Road.
5. Clonskeagh Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. York Road,

9. Brennanstown Road.
10. Sandyford Business Park.

These works will continue until Friday, 30th August 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
