ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75, Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Road Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Castle Street** from The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey to Allied Irish Bank on **Saturday** 24th August, 2019 and Sunday 25th August, 2019 from 11 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. in order to facilitate **Dalkey Lobster Festival**.

The purpose of the closure is to create a safe and family friendly community atmosphere for the Lobster Festival with Cookery Demonstrations, Street Entertainment etc.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019

Dún Laoghaire/Rathdown County Council, Wicklow County Council and South Dublin County Council have made orders to temporarily close the enclosed listed roads on **Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th August 2019**, as detailed herein, to facilitate **The Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019**

The Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019 will involve a 1.2 mile swim, 56 mile cycle and 13.1 mile run. The swim will take place early morning in Scotsman's Bay, Dún Laoghaire, followed by a cycle from Dún Laoghaire that will head to Kilternan, then south through Enniskerry

to Roundwood, turning west to the Sally Gap, then north through Glencree to Cruagh Road before turning east back through Glencullen and Kilternan to Dun Laoghaire. The run will then take place in Dun Laoghaire along the seafront.

Local access will be maintained at all times, where possible, and diversion routes clearly sign-posted.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Hillcrest Road, Sandyford

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council have made an order to temporarily close Hillcrest Road, Sandyford, from the junction of Kilgobbin Road to the junction with Enniskerry Road from **Monday 19**th **August to Friday 23rd August 2019 inclusive**, between **9.00 a.m**. and **5.00 p.m**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road patching and safety improvement works on Hillcrest Road by the dlr Roads Maintenance Section.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion route will be clearly sign-posted. Access to Sandyford Village / Sandyford Road from Kilgobbin Road will be unaffected. Local access to Hillcrest Road will be maintained.

Diversion of traffic will be via Kilgobbin Road and Enniskerry Road and vice versa.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Tivoli Road and Corrig Road ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Tivoli Road and Corrig Road**, from the junction of Tivoli Road with York Road to the Junction of
Corrig Road with Glenageary Road Lower from **6**th **August**, **2019 to 20**th **September**, **2019**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

Phase 1 - Road/Footpath Restoration and associated works will start during week commencing: **Monday, 12th August 2019** for duration of **6-Weeks**. Works will be undertaken between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. (Monday to Saturday)

A Traffic Management Plan and signed detours will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Frascati Road, Blackrock *** (Day & Night works)

Trenching and ducting works on behalf of ESB Networks will continue on Monday, 19th August 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 10:00 and 15:30 hrs. and night works between 19:00 and 23:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Glenamuck Road – outside Rockville Development **

Watermain works will commence on Thursday, 22nd and Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Honeypark Permeability, Sallynoggin area ***

Cosgrave Developments will carry out works as part of the granted planning permissions to provide pedestrian/cycleway links from Honeypark Development through/to Sefton, Sallynoggin Park, O'Rourke Park and Rollins Villas.

The outline programme of works is as follows:

- Sefton Link and Sallynoggin Park Link 14th to 23rd August 2019
- O'Rourke Park/Rollins Villas Link 26th to 30th August 2019

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

» George's Street Lower *** (Night works)

Richard Nolan Civil Engineering Ltd. will carry out footpath reinstatement repair works on George's Street Lower from its junction with Sussex Street up the entrance to St. Michael's Hospital on Monday, 19th August 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 with restriction working hours between 19:00 to 23:00.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

» Sandyford Road ** at the entrance to the Council Depot

Re-alignment of the cycle track at the entrance to the Council Depot to commence on or after Monday, 19th August 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction / installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts / supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for works on the N11 and N31. Traffic lane restrictions or footway / cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Installation of Sign Foundations *

Installation of sign foundations will take place on: Glenamuck Road South, Station Road, Carrickbrennan Road, Adelaide Road, Woodlands Road, Quinn's Road, Goatstown Road, Ballinteer Road, Harold's Grange Road and Eden Road Lower from Monday, 29th July 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Killiney Road, Killiney ***

Footpath restoration works will continue until Friday, 30th August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Old Connaught Avenue/Dublin Road, Bray **

Works are being carried out on the Old Connaught Avenue / Dublin Road in Bray by GMC on behalf of Irish Water from Tuesday 6th August to Friday 30th August 2019.

There will be no access to Old Connaught Avenue from the Dublin Road.

A diversion is in place via Junction 6 - Fassaroe.

Goatstown Road *** at Our Lady's Grove School

Construction of a new pedestrian crossing commenced on Tuesday, 6th August 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place until *end of August 2019* with traffic restrictions between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

Clonskeagh Road, Clonskeagh *** from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road commenced on Monday, 4th March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place *until end of August 2019* with traffic restrictions between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

George's Avenue and Blackrock Main Street (part of) ***

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 29th July 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Rosmeen Gardens, Dún Laoghaire **

Footpath restoration works commenced on Tuesday, 6^{th} August 2019 until Friday, 23^{rd} August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Brennanstown Road, Foxrock – new Residential Development ***

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15^{th} July 2019 until Friday, 15^{th} November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of north and south bound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and south bound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filing stations on N11, Cabinteely. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion *September 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane - north bound carriageway only) ***

Works commenced on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until *autumn 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Deansgrange Road
- 3. Mounttown Road
- 4. Abbey Road
- 5. Clonskeagh Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Stradbrook Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until Friday 29th November 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **August**, internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
