ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 2 of 2019 on the N11 Dual Carriageway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the construction of the new signalised junction on the N11 at Cabinteely, south of the Johnstown Road junction, has made an Order entitled "Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2019 on the **N11 Dual Carriageway** in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown" to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

The Special Speed Limit of 60 km/hr will be valid for the N11 Southbound and Northbound and will run from 07/10/2019 until 01/03/2020 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

The location of the special speed limit will be for part of the Southbound and Northbound carriageways of the N11 between a point 425 metres South of the existing junction of the N11 with Johnstown Road, to a point 1015 metres North of the R118 overbridge (at the junction of N11 / Wyattville Road). The length of road subject to this speed limit is 400m.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Clonskeagh Road / Beech Hill Road *****

Joint Bay excavation works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Monday, 13th January 2020 until Thursday, 16th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Near Marine View Apartments, Marine Road, Dún Laoghaire *****

Ducting works, on behalf of Eir, will commence on Sunday, 12th January 2020 for one day between 09:00 and 14:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Glensavage Avoca Road, Blackrock *****

Trenching and ducting works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Monday, 13th January 2020 until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Frascati Road, Blackrock *****

Road resurfacing works will commence on Wednesday, 15th January 2020 until Thursday, 16th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Enniskerry Road – Village Road Junction *****

Trenching and ducting works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Thursday, 16th January 2020 until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Beechpark Residential Development, Bray Road ****

Excavation works on public footpath to locate existing main and make connection to existing watermain will commence on Monday, 13th January, 2020 until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Lower Kilmacud Road ***

Concrete footpath repairs commenced on Tuesday, 7th January 2020 for one month between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Brewery Road near N11 junction *****

Site investigation work (slit-trenches) will commence at various locations on Brewery Road approaching the Stillorgan Road junction on dates during January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the work.

» **Glenageary Road Upper
(Section between Sallynoggin Roundabout and The Graduate
Rouncabout) ****

Upgrading of public lighting columns will commence on Monday, 13th January 2020 until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Kilcross Estate- The Court Sandyford *

Footpath works commenced on Monday, 6th January 2020 until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works *
(Night works)**

Lining works on the cycle track at Junctions Oakdown/Whitebarn/Meadow Park Avenue and Nutgrove Way + will continue until Friday, 17th January 2020 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Westminster Road – Gordon Avenue to Hainault **

Bitimous footpath repairs will continue until Friday, 31st January 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Woodbrook Glen, off Old Connaught Avenue **

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 6th January 2020 until Friday, 24th January 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by mid-2020.

During **January**, internal construction of the building will be completed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes, and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely.

Works in the Median will begin from 7th October and will continue to end January 2020.

2 lanes in both directions will be maintained, and as the lanes will be narrowed, a Special Speed Limit of **60km/hr.** will apply for the duration of the works in the median.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and the traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction during the night work.

Rochestown Avenue at the National Rehabilitation Hospital *** (Day and Night works)

Civil works associated with the National Rehabilitation Hospital will continue until Friday, 31st January 2020 – 24hours / 7 days per week.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until April 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31st July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on 2nd September 2019 and run *for 16 consecutive weeks*. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace commenced on 2nd September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.
