ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 2 of 2019 on the N11 Dual Carriageway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the construction of the new signalised junction on the N11 at Cabinteely, south of the Johnstown Road junction, has made an Order entitled "Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2019 on the **N11 Dual Carriageway** in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown" to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

The Special Speed Limit of 60 km/hr will be valid for the N11 Southbound and Northbound and will run from 07/10/2019 until 01/03/2020 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

The location of the special speed limit will be for part of the Southbound and Northbound carriageways of the N11 between a point 425 metres South of the existing junction of the N11 with Johnstown Road, to a point 1015 metres North of the R118 overbridge (at the junction of N11 / Wyattville Road). The length of road subject to this speed limit is 400m.

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993** **Temporary Closure of Enniskerry Road, Stepside**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from the Stepside Business Association for the temporary closure of a section of **Enniskerry Road**, from the junction with Burrow Road southwards through Stepside Village to the junction with Glenamuck Road South from **1.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.** on **Tuesday 17th March, 2020.**

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate a **St. Patrick's Day Parade** and associated events in **Stepside Village.**

Diversion of traffic will be via Hillcrest Road, Kilgobbin Road, Ballyogan Road and Glenamuck Road South and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

ROAD CLOSURE

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993** **Temporary Closure of Castlepark Road, Dalkey**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Roads Maintenance Section has made an order to temporarily close **Castlepark Road (Part of)** from its junction with Barnhill Road to its Junction with Hyde Road from **Monday 17th February, 2020 to Friday 13th March, 2020 inclusive.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Junction N11 /Kill Lane – footpath works on the Inbound Lane ** ***

Reinstating footpath works will commence on Monday, 17th February 2020 until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Dún Laoghaire Harbour – East Pier (outside National Yacht Club) ***

Concrete footpath and reconstruction works will commence on the East Pier (outside the National Yacht Club) on Monday, 17th February 2020 until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

There will be some parking bay suspensions for the duration of the works.

» **Bray Road, Cornelscourt ** ***

Tree works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Thursday, 20th February 2020 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Brennanstown Road, Cabinteely ** ***

Tree works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Friday, 21st February 2020 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Castlepark Road, Dalkey (Part of) Phase 1 Works ** ***

Phase 1 – road, footpath restoration and associated works will be implemented on Castlepark Road during the week of Wednesday, 19th February 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for Phase 1 works.

George's Street Lower, Dún Laoghaire ** *

Cabling works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Sunday, 16th February 2020 for one day between 08:00 and 12:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Oakdown Road Junction with Churchtown Road Upper **

Repair of flooding issues will continue until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

**# Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works **
(Night works)**

Lining works on the cycle track at Junctions Oakdown/Whitebarn/Meadow Park Avenue and Nutgrove Way + will continue until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Westminster Road – Gordon Avenue to Hainault **

Bitimous footpath repairs will continue until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Glensavage Avoca Road, Blackrock ***

Footpath and road reinstatement work, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Monday, 17th February 2020 until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Deerpark Road, Mount Merrion **

Road resurfacing works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will continue until Sunday, 16th February 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» St. Bridget's Park / Mart Lane, Cornelscourt **

Road resurfacing works, on behalf of ESB Networks, will commence on Monday, 17th February 2020 until Friday, 21st February 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Mellifont Avenue, Dún Laoghaire **

Footpath restoration and associated works will commence on Mellifont Avenue during the week commencing Monday, 3rd February 2020 until Friday 21st February 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Rochestown Avenue at the National Rehabilitation Hospital ** (Day and Night works)

Civil works associated with the National Rehabilitation Hospital will continue until Monday, 16th March 2020 – 24hours / 7 days per week.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Lower Kilmacud Road *

Concrete footpath repairs will continue until end of February 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes, and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely.

2 lanes in both directions will be maintained, and as the lanes will be narrowed, a Special Speed Limit of **60km/hr.** will apply for the duration of the works in the median and either side of the N11.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and the traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction during the night work as necessary.

Rock Road / Frascati Road, Blackrock ** (intermittent)

Public lighting column upgrade works commenced on Wednesday, 22nd January 2020 until Friday, 13th March 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and 19:00 to 23:00 hrs. if required.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprises are undertaking the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works are being undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted to between 08:00 and 18:00hrs. It is anticipated that works will be completed in March 2020.

Clonmel Enterprises are implementing various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace and George's Street Upper with access along Haigh Terrace maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace are suspended for the duration of the works.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by mid-2020.

During **February**, internal construction of the building will be completed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until April 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinlea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31st July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
