EVENTS

»...Enniskerry Road, Stepside

Dún Laoghaire- Rathdown County Council have been informed that the **St. Patrick's Day Parade** and associated events in **Stepside Village** have been **Cancelled**.

ROAD CLOSURE

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 **Temporary Closure of Castlepark Road, Dalkey**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Roads Maintenance Section has made an order to temporarily close **Castlepark Road (Part of)** from its junction with Barnhill Road to its Junction with Hyde Road from **Monday 17th February 2020 to Friday 13th March 2020 inclusive**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will always be maintained and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

»...Harold's Grange Road / College Road, Sandyford ***

Site investigation works will commence on Monday, 9th March 2020 until Tuesday, 10th March 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

»...Blackglen Road / Sandyford Road / Enniskerry Road ***

Site investigation works will commence on Saturday, 14th March 2020 until Sunday, 15th March 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

»...Drummartin Road / Lower Kilmacud Road / Drummartin Shops ***

Road reconstruction will commence on Monday, 9th March 2020 until Friday, 13th March 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

»...Nutgrove Avenue, Rathfarnham ** (Night works)

Trial hole works will commence on Monday, 9th March 2020 until Friday, 13th March 2020 between 19:00 and 04:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

»...Marine Terrace, Dún Laoghaire **

Essential road repairs will commence on Marine Terrace on Saturday, 14th March 2020, for one day, between 09:00 and 14:00 hrs.

While works are being undertaken Local Access and Egress to Marine Terrace and Mellifont Avenue will be maintained via the Junction of Georges Street Upper.

A signed diversion Route will be in operation for the duration of the works.

»...**Corke Abbey Avenue and The Drive, Bray ****

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 9th March 2020 until Friday 27th March 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

The Drive - 08:00 – 18:00 hrs.

Abbey Avenue – 09:30 – 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

During **March**, repair of the building roof will commence, along with preparation for window installations. Structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Adelaide Road, Dún Laoghaire*

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 9th March 2020 for a period of 5-weeks.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works **
(Night works)

Lining works on the cycle track at Junctions Oakdown/Whitebarn/Meadow Park Avenue and Nutgrove Way and will continue until Friday, 13th March 2020 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Castlepark Road, Dalkey (Part of) Phase 1 Works **

Road and footpath restoration works will continue until Friday 13th March 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

Road closure will be in place until 13th March 2020.

Rochestown Avenue at the National Rehabilitation Hospital **
(Day and Night works)

Civil works associated with the National Rehabilitation Hospital will continue until Monday, 16th March 2020 – 24hours / 7 days per week.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Rock Road / Frascati Road, Blackrock ** (intermittent)

Public lighting column upgrade works commenced on Wednesday, 22nd January 2020 until Friday, 13th March 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and 19:00 to 23:00 hrs. if required.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprises are undertaking the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works are being undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted to between 08:00 and 18:00hrs. It is anticipated that works will be completed in March 2020.

Clonmel Enterprises are implementing various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace and George's Street Upper with access along Haigh Terrace maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace are suspended for the duration of the works.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until April 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinlea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31st July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
