PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**
Temporary Closure of Adelaide Road, Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Roads Maintenance Section has requested the temporary closure of **Adelaide Road** from the junction of Silchester Road to its junction with Eden Road Lower and Hudson Road from the **14th April 2020 to 26th June 2020**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works. The diversion routes are outlined below:

- Traffic approaching from Glenageary Road Upper will be diverted. Primary diversion route will be Silchester Road via Glenageary Road Lower and Eden Road.
- Traffic approaching from Eden Road will be diverted via Hudson Road Albert Road, Glenageary Road Upper onto Adelaide Road.
- Traffic approaching from Hudson Road will be diverted via Eden Road, Glenageary Road Lower and Silchester Road.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

Rochestown Avenue at the National Rehabilitation Hospital ** (Day and Night works)

Civil works associated with the National Rehabilitation Hospital will continue until Friday, 24th April 2020 – 24hours / 7 days per week.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Adelaide Road, Dún Laoghaire*

Restoration works will continue until Thursday, 9th April 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprises are undertaking the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works are being undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted to between 08:00 and 18:00hrs. It is anticipated that the major elements of the works will be completed during April 2020.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace are suspended for the duration of the works.

Balally Estate, Dundrum **

Repair trip hazard works will continue until Friday, 17th April 2020 between 08:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works, Rathfarnham** (Night works)

Lining works on the cycle track at Junctions Oakdown/Whitebarn/Meadow Park Avenue and Nutgrove Way will continue until Friday, 3rd April 2020 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Drummartin Road and Lower Kilmacud Road / Drummartin Shops ***

Road reconstruction will continue until Friday, 3rd April 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works will commence on Monday, 23rd March 2020 until 30th November 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Carysfort Avenue, Blackrock - Signalised Pedestrian Crossing **

Actavo (Ireland) Ltd. are undertaking the Signalised Pedestrian Crossing works on Carysfort Avenue, close to Carysfort Park Junction, the works will include new Signalised Controlled Pedestrian Crossing.

Works will commence on Monday, 23rd March 2020 for 4-weeks approx.

The works are being undertaken on a phased and Stop/Go basis with working hours restricted between 10:00 and 16:00hrs. It is anticipated that works will be completed in April 2020.

Corke Abbey Avenue and The Drive, Bray **

Footpath restoration works will continue until Friday, 3rd April 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

The Drive - 08:00 – 18:00 hrs.

Abbey Avenue – 09:30 – 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Rock Road / Frascati Road, Blackrock ** (intermittent)

Public lighting column upgrade works will continue until Friday, 1st May 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and 19:00 to 23:00 hrs. if required.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

During **March**, repair of the building roof will commence along with preparation for window installations. Structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until April 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31st July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
