ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

Adelaide Road - (24-hour Road Closure) ***

Road Restoration works and associated 24-hour Road Closure will commence on **Adelaide Road** from Monday, 25th May 2020 until **26th June 2020** (inclusive).

Adelaide Road will be closed from the junction of Silchester Road to its Junction with Eden Road Lower and Hudson Road for the duration of the works.

From Monday, 25th May 2020:

- A ONE-WAY SYSTEM will be in operation between the Junction of Station Road and Eden Road / Hudson Road.
- There will be NO ACCESS to Adelaide Road from the Junction of Eden Road Lower and Hudson Road.
- LOCAL ACCESS for will be maintained via the junction of Silchester Road.
- LOCAL EGRESS will be maintained via the junction of Eden Road / Hudson Road.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 hrs. and 18:00hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches.
- Traffic Management Arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

Dundrum Main Street junction with Kilmacud Road Upper Contractor working on the Corner premises, Ryan's Pub **

Lift Hire Ireland will be operating a Stop/Go at the junction to allow for works to be completed on Ryan's Pub.

Works will commence on Tuesday, 2nd June 2020 for one week.

The works are being undertaken using a Stop/Go system with working hours restricted between 10:00 and 16:00hrs

» Balally Estate, Dundrum *

Concrete footpath works will continue until Friday, 5^{th} June 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Lower Kilmacud Road, Kilmacud ***

Footpaths and road reconstruction works will continue until Friday, 26th June 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Sweetman's Avenue, Blackrock **

Reinstatement works will commence, on behalf of Irish Water, on Wednesday, 3rd June 2020 for one day between 09:30 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Abbey Road and Junctions with Abbeyview Road and St. Fintan's Villas, Monkstown ******

Road works commenced on Tuesday, 5th May 2020 until Tuesday, <u>30th June</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Churchtown Road Upper (St. Nahi's Church) **

Installation of a foul sewer will commence on Monday, 25th May 2020 until Saturday, <u>13th June</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works recommenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 and will continue until <u>30th November</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 20:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the northern verge and central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until <u>October 2020</u>.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire *

Clonmel Enterprises are undertaking the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works are being undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted to between 08:00 and 18:00hrs. Progress on site has been impacted by recent Covid-19 restrictions and it is anticipated that the major elements of the works will now be completed in <u>May/June2020</u>.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace are suspended for the duration of the works.

Carysfort Avenue, Blackrock - Signalised Pedestrian Crossing **

Actavo (Ireland) Ltd. are undertaking the Signalised Pedestrian Crossing works on Carysfort Avenue, close to Carysfort Park Junction, the works will include new Signalised Controlled Pedestrian Crossing.

Works commenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 for <u>4-weeks</u> approx.

The works are being undertaken on a phased and Stop/Go basis with working hours restricted between 10:00 and 16:00hrs. It is anticipated that works will be completed in <u>June 2020</u>.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

During **May / June**, the building will be made weather tight. Structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. Installation of pedestrian deck will commence. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Killiney Road
- 3. Tivoli Road
- 4. Avondale Road
- 5. Ballinclea Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. Woodbine Road
- 9. Vico Road
- 10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31^{st} July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
