ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Blackrock Village Scheme - Covid 19 Public Realm Project ***

Richard Nolan Civil Engineering Ltd have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the One-Way Scheme along Rock Hill and Main Street in Blackrock village as part of Covid-19 temporary measures in the public realm in DLR. The scheme includes the temporary widening of footpaths and installation of a contra flow cycle lane to facilitate social distancing measures within the Blackrock Village. The works will be carried out in two phases as follows:

Phase 1: Commence site works on Monday, 8th June 2020:

- Install one-way system using a system of black pencil bollards, carry out changes to traffic signals and install new traffic signage, complete line marking.
- Remove any redundant signage and remove or reposition any existing street furniture to optimize available space.

Phase 2: Commence site works on Monday, 29th June 2020:

- Install 'narrow lane defender' separators between one-way traffic lane and reallocated space on both sides of Rock Hill/Main Street.
- Install anti-skid on reallocated space.
- Complete remaining line marking.
- Install planters and street furniture.

A Traffic Management Plan with a one-way system will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted.

- Close off Left lane from Frascati Road to Carysfort Avenue with cones and barriers to be positioned along kerb edge for Phase 1 works. Following completion of works in Left lane, Traffic Management will swap over to Right hand lane.
- Permanent Traffic lights at Bath Place will be adjusted for one-way system.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 and 23:00 hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches [approach roads] to Blackrock Village.
- Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

» Adelaide Road (24-hour Road Closure) ***

Road restoration works and associated 24-hour Road Closure will commence on Adelaide Road from Monday, 8thJune 2020 until Thursday, 11th June 2020 (inclusive).

Adelaide Road <u>will be closed</u> from the junction of Silchester Road, its junction with Eden Road Lower and Hudson Road for the duration of the works.

From Monday, 8th June 2020:

- Adelaide Road will be closed between St. Paul's Terrace and St. Peter's Terrace.
- There will be NO ACCESS to Eden Road Lower and Hudson Road via Adelaide Road.
- LOCAL ACCESS / EGRESS for residents on the Upper side of St. Paul's Terrace will be maintained via the junction of Silchester Road.
- LOCAL ACCESS / EGRESS for residents on the Lower side of St. Peter's Terrace will be maintained via the junction of Eden Road / Hudson Road.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches.
- Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

» Foxrock Village ***

Footpath improvement works will commence at the corner of Brighton Road and Westminster Court on Wednesday, 10th June 2020. Works will take place between 09:00 and 18:00 hrs. weekdays.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place throughout.

» Protected Cycle Routes - Various Locations around the County *** (Night Works)

Installation of flexible bollards at junctions around the County to commence Monday, June 8th, 2020 and will take place over a period of <u>two to three weeks</u> between 19:00 and 07:00 hrs.

Dundrum Area:

- Taney Road / Churchtown Road junction (Luas Bridge junction).
- Kilmacud Road Lower approaching Taney Road junction (near the Goat Pub).
- Sandyford Road approaching Wyckham Way junction.
- Kilmacud Road Upper and Drummartin Road junction.
- Kilmacud Road Upper and St. Raphaela's Road junction.

Dun Laoghaire Area:

- Stillorgan Park Road / Fleurville approaching the Carysfort Avenue junction.
- Newtownpark Avenue and Rowanbyrn Road / Annaville Terrace junction.
- Deans Grange Road Brookville Park junction.
- Kill Lane approaching the Super Valu entrance.
- Temple Road approaching Newtown Avenue Junction.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation at each location for the duration of the works.

» Haigh Terrace, Dún Laoghaire *

Buff coloured anti-skid surface works will commence on Monday, 8th June 2020 until Thursday, <u>11th June</u> 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

» Mount Anville Road / Deerpark Road **

Concrete footpath works will commence on Monday, 8th June 2020 until Friday, <u>12th June</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Broadford Road (The Oaks) *

Footpath repairs will continue until Friday, $\underline{19^{th}}$ June 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Abbey Road and Junctions with Abbeyview Road and St. Fintan's Villas, Monkstown ******

Road works commenced on Tuesday, 5th May 2020 until Tuesday, <u>30th June</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Churchtown Road Upper (St. Nahi's Church) **

Installation of a foul sewer will continue until Saturday, $\underline{13^{th} June}$ 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the northern verge and central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until <u>October 2020</u>.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works recommenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 and will continue until <u>30th November</u> 2020 between 08:00 and 20:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Carysfort Avenue, Blackrock - Signalised Pedestrian Crossing **

Actavo (Ireland) Ltd. are undertaking the Signalised Pedestrian Crossing works on Carysfort Avenue, close to Carysfort Park Junction, the works will include new Signalised Controlled Pedestrian Crossing.

Works commenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 for <u>4-weeks</u> approx.

The works are being undertaken on a phased and Stop/Go basis with working hours restricted between 10:00 and 16:00hrs. It is anticipated that works will be completed in <u>June 2020</u>.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

During **May / June**, the building will be made weather tight. Structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. Installation of pedestrian deck will commence. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Killiney Road
- 3. Tivoli Road
- 4. Avondale Road
- 5. Ballinclea Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. Woodbine Road
- 9. Vico Road
- 10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 31^{st} July 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.
