ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Grove Avenue, Blackrock.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities Group, Millennium Bus Park, Cappagh, Dublin 11, to temporarily close Grove Avenue, Blackrock to through traffic from the junction of Grove Avenue/Avoca Avenue to junction of **Grove Avenue/Avoca Road** from Tuesday 27th of October, 2020 to Monday 9th of November 2020.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the placing of one 125mm water main in the road on behalf of Irish Water. Local access will be maintained throughout the works.

The proposed diversion route will be via Avoca Avenue, Glenart Avenue and Avoca Road.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of these works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Shanganagh Road / Side Entrance to Scoil Mhuire Catholic Primary School, Shankill ****

Restoration works will be undertaken at Side Entrance to Scoil Mhuire Catholic Primary School, Shankill during the week commencing Monday 12th October 2020 to Friday, 16th October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. Works impacting on Shanganagh Road will be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Crofton Road (N31) *****

Site investigation works will be undertaken on Crofton Road (N31) during the week commencing Monday, 12th October 2020 to Friday, 16th October 2020 between 10:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Junction of Kilmacud Road Upper and Sydenham Road ** (Day and Night Works)

Installation of lining, loop cutting and raising of iron works will continue until Friday 16th October 2020 between 09:30 and 16:30 hrs. There will also be night works required between 19:00 and 00:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballyogan Road at junction of Kilgobbin Road ***

Road repairs will continue until Friday, 16th October 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Myrtle Park, Dún Laogharie ***

Footpath restoration works (extended) will continue until Friday, 30th October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the northern verge and central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until mid-November 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballinteer Road (Lynwood Estate to Mayfield Terrace) **

Footpath restoration works will commence on Wednesday 7th October 2020 and will continue until Friday 30th October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Pine Valley Avenue, Pine Valley Estate, Rathfarnham *

Footpath restoration works will commence on Wednesday, 7th October 2020 and will continue until Friday, 30th October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Dalkey Village ***

Works are on-going in Dalkey Village and will continue until approximately late October between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Newtownpark Avenue - Site Investigation Works ***

Site investigation works will take place on Newtownpark Avenue approaching the N11 Junction.

Works will commence on Monday 5th October 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and will continue for up to two weeks.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place with traffic diversions.

Goatstown Road * (Night Works)**

Installation of delineation kerb for cycle lane will continue until mid-October 2020 between 19:00 and 05:00 hrs.

Day works may also take place between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Nutgrove Avenue, Churchtown **
(Day & Night Works)

Installation of lining and raising of ironworks on the cycle path will continue until Friday 16th October 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. There will also be night works required between 20:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Tullyvale Road at the junction to Druid Valley***

Installation of ducting works will start during the week commencing Monday, 21st September 2020 until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go System will be in operation to allow one lane of traffic at all times.

N11 – Southbound
(between Stillorgan Park Junction and Brewery Road Junction) **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns.

Works will continue until Wednesday, 27th November 2020 (intermittent) from 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. and 19:30 to Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works recommenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 and will continue until 30th November 2020 between 08:00 and 20:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Dundrum Village ***

DLR Traffic Section are installing a **One-Way System**, Northbound only, on Dundrum Main Street and on Sandyford Road for 140m from Dundrum Cross.

Access to Upper Kilmacud Road from Dundrum Cross will also be prohibited.

These measures are for an indefinite duration.

Enniskerry Road / Village Road Junction **

Removal of concrete footpath, installation of boundary wall, construction of new bus layby and reinstatement of new footpath commenced Monday, 10th August 2020 and will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 to 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road Upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 22nd December 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Work on the structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. Installation of pedestrian deck has commenced.

There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Sandyford Cycle Route (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road) ***

Provision of footpaths, two-way cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works. Project works will continue until **May 2021**.

Traffic Management measures will be in operation at the following locations until further notice:

- all approaches to the junction of Drummartin Link Road and Blackthorn Drive
- all approaches to Junction 14 - M50 Rotary
- hard shoulder closed on Drummartin Link Road between Blackthorn Drive and J14 M50 Rotary.
