PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Clonmel Enterprises to temporarily close **Castle Street, Dalkey** from its junction with White's Villas to its junction with Convent Road from Sunday, 15th November 2020 to Tuesday, 17th November 2020 inclusive.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Resurfacing the Road Carriageway.

Any interested parties may lodge an objection in writing with the Senior Engineer, Traffic Section, County Hall, Marine Road, Dún Laoghaire not later than **noon on Monday, 9th November 2020** or email info@dlrcoco.ie.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Grove Avenue, Blackrock

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Grove Avenue, Blackrock** to through traffic from the junction of Grove Avenue/Avoca Avenue to junction of Grove Avenue/Avoca Road from Tuesday 27th of October 2020 to Monday 9th of November 2020.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the placing of one 125mm water main in the road on behalf of Irish Water. Local access will be maintained throughout the works.

The proposed diversion route will be via Avoca Avenue, Glenart Avenue and Avoca Road.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of these works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

White's Cross N11 - Stillorgan Road and Leopardstown Road ***

Excavation in bus lane inbound will continue until Friday, 20th November 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00.

Bus Lane will be closed.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the works.

>> Rock Road, Blackrock ***

Ground investigation works, for Bus Connects project, will commence on Wednesday, 4th November 2020 until Friday, 6th November 2020 for 2-days between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Location 1: on footpath adjacent to Blackrock Park.
will require partial lane closure Southbound.

Location 2: on footpath just south of Junction with Castledawson Avenue.
will require partial lane closure Northbound.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Enniskerry Road – R117, Kilternan *****

Road surfacing works (at entrance to Bishop’s Gate development) will commence on Monday, 2nd and Tuesday, 3rd November 2020 for 2-days between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Cruagh Greenway Extension ***

DLR Traffic Section will commence construction of a 250m extension of the Cruagh Greenway on the week of Monday, 2nd November 2020 and will last 9-weeks.

Minimal disruption to the local roads is expected during the works.

» **N11 Stillorgan Road *****

Site investigation works will commence on Monday, 2nd November 2020 for 1-day between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Lane 2 will be closed on the Outbound and Inbound Carriageway on the N11 south of Stillorgan Park Junction.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Nutgrove Avenue, Churchtown – at The Bottle Tower ****

Lining works will commence on Monday, 2nd November 2020 until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Dalkey Village ***

Works are on-going in Dalkey Village and will continue until Tuesday, 17th November 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Goatstown Road *
(Night Works)**

Installation of delineation kerb for cycle lane will continue until mid-November 2020 between 19:00 and 05:00 hrs.

Day works may also take place between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Ballyogan Road - Protected Cycle Track Works ***

Installation of flexible bollards on Ballyogan Road approaching various junctions along the whole route.

Works to commence during week starting Monday, 2nd November 2020 and will continue for up to 2-weeks between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the works.

Myrtle Park, Dún Laoghaire *

Footpath restoration works (extended) will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Adelaide Road, Glenageary *

Snagging works will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Station Road, Glenageary *

Snagging works will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Villarea Park, Glenageary *

Snagging works will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Kilmacud House, Kilmacud Road Upper ***

Road reinstatement works (adjacent to a new development) will commence on Thursday, 29th October 2020 until Thursday, 5th November 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Tivoli Road and Eglinton Park, Dún Laoghaire **

Snagging works will be undertaken on Tivoli Road and Eglinton Park during the week commencing Monday, 26th October 2020 to Friday, 6th November 2020 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs. when Schools are closed and between 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. when Schools are open.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Road - Protected Cycle Track Works ***

Installation of flexible bollards on Stillorgan Road approaching Kill Lane, Old Dublin Road and Mount Merrion Avenue.

Works to commence during week starting Tuesday, 27th October 2020 and will continue for up to 2-weeks between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the works.

Shanganagh Road, Shanganagh **

Footpath and associated works are to be undertaken to link the existing footpaths at St Anne's Church through to the Starlings, on the west side of Shanganagh Road, from Wednesday, 14th October and will run for a period of 12-weeks. Stop/Go will be in place between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs., with occasional All Stop (maximum 3-minutes) 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Enniskerry Road / Aikens Village Road Junction **

Removal of concrete footpath, installation of boundary wall, construction of new bus layby and reinstatement of new footpath commenced Monday, 10th August 2020 and will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 to 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Tullyvale Road at the junction to Druid Valley***

Installation of ducting works will start during the week commencing Monday, 21st September 2020 until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go System will be in operation to allow one lane of traffic at all times.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the northern verge and central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until mid-November 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 – Southbound (between Stillorgan Park Junction and Brewery Road Junction) **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns.

Works will continue until Wednesday, 27th November 2020 (intermittent) from 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. and 19:30 to Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works recommenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 and will continue until 30th November 2020 between 08:00 and 20:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road Upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 22nd December 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Work on the structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. Installation of pedestrian deck has commenced.

There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Sandyford Cycle Route (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road) ***

Provision of footpaths, two-way cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works. Project works will continue until **May 2021**.

Traffic Management measures will be in operation at the following locations until further notice:

- all approaches to the junction of Drummartin Link Road and Blackthorn Drive
- all approaches to Junction 14 - M50 Rotary
- hard shoulder closed on Drummartin Link Road between Blackthorn Drive and J14 M50 Rotary.
