ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CORRIG ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Corrig Road** from its junction with Mulgrave Street to its junction with Glenageary Road Lower/Eden Road Upper. The closure will run from **Monday**, **29**th **March 2021** to **Friday**, **6**th **August 2021**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Sandyford Cycle Route *** (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road)

Road resurfacing works will commence on Tuesday, 4th May 2021 until Friday, 7th May 2021 at the junction of Kilgobbin Road / Hillcrest Road.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management System will be in operation on all approaches to the junction from 9:30 until 16:00 hrs. daily.

» Stillorgan Road (N11) ** (+ Night works)

Terra Solutions Ltd. commenced works, to carry out CCTV survey of the stormwater drainage, on Stillorgan Road N11 on Tuesday, 4th May 2021 and will continue until Friday, <u>28thMay</u> 2021 between:

- 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. for the day works.
- 20:00 to 23:00 hrs. for the night works generate noise.
- 20:00 to 06:00 hrs. for the night works do not generate noise.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Overend Avenue and Sydenham Villas **

Reinstatement works will commence on Tuesday, 4th March 2021 and will continue until Friday, 7th May 2021 between:

- 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. at Overend Avenue
- 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. at Sydenham Villas

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Dublin Road / Cork Little, Bray **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are implementing a single lane closure along Dublin Road (close to Crinken Church) on Tuesday, 4th May 2021 until Wednesday, 5th May 202 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation

» Station Road (outside Killiney Dart Station), Killiney **

Road resurfacing works will commence on Tuesday, 4th May 2021 until Friday 7th May 2021 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs.

Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation

Saval Park Road, Dalkey **

Essential road restoration and associated works will continue until Friday, $\underline{25^{th}}$ **June** 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop/ Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wynberg Park, Blackrock ***

Footpath restoration works will continue until Friday, 7th May 2021. Works will primarily be undertaken between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. However, works that impact on Stradbrook Road will be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Knapton Road, Monkstown **

Pedestrian improvement works will continue (on Knapton Road, at the junction with Mounttown Road Lower) until Friday, 7th May 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Goatstown Road *** Junction at Goatstown Road / Larchfield to Our Lady's Grove

Installation of a sewer for Irish Water commenced on Wednesday, 24^{th} March 2021 and will continue until Friday, 7^{th} May 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

- Lane closure in place from the Junction of Goatstown Road and Roebuck Road Junction for Southbound traffic.
- Access maintained Southbound on Goatstown Road for Bus routes only.
- Northbound traffic remains open on Goatstown Road.
- Local diversions in place via Roebuck Road and Mount Anville Road.

Corrig Road, Dún Laoghaire - (24-hour Road Closure) ***

A 24-hour Road Closure will be in place on Corrig Road from its junction with Mulgrave Terrace to its Junction with Glenageary Road Lower from:

Monday, 29th March 2021 until Friday, 6th August 2021

to facilitate essential Road / Footpath Restoration and associated works.

- A ONE-WAY SYSTEM will be in operation on Corrig Road between the Junctions of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace and Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- There will be NO ACCESS to Corrig Road from the Junction of Glenageary Road Upper/Corrig Road. Diversion will be in place to direct vehicles around to the Junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace for access to one-way system.
- LOCAL ACCESS will be maintained via the junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace.
- LOCAL EGRESS will be maintained via the junction of Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- Access to Corrig Park, Corrig Avenue, Clarinda Park West, Crosthwaite Park and Royal Terrace will be via the one-way system gaining access from Tivoli Road /Mulgrave Terrace Junction.
- When exiting Corrig Park, Corrig Ave and Clarinda Park East, there will be NO Right Turn onto Corrig Road. Egress is via Left turn towards Corrig Road /Glenageary Road Junction.
- When Exiting Royal Terrace and Crosthwaite Park, there will be NO left turn in place. Egress is via Right hand turn towards Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Junction.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches.
- Traffic Management Arrangements will remain in place <u>overnight</u> for the duration of the works.

Drummartin Road Junction with Eden Park **

Telecom/Civil works will commence, on behalf of Delmec Engineering Ltd. on Monday, 26th April 2021 until Friday, 7th May 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Castlepark Road, Dalkey ***

Pedestrian improvement works at junctions will continue until end May 2021.

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 **

(between Brewery Road Junction and Kilmacud Lower Junction) Intermittent.

Upgrading Public Lighting Columns, Lanterns and associated Civil Works commenced on Tuesday, 6th April 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. (19:00 – 00:00 if required) for approximately <u>3-months</u> - (end **July** 2021).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.
