ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary closure of Claremont Road, Dublin 18

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Claremont Road** (between Brighton Road/ Brennanstown Road junction up to and including Kerrymount Avenue Roundabout from

Monday, 5th July 2021 to Saturday, 31st July 2021

inclusive in order to facilitate Claremont Road Upgrade works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Diversion routes will be Foxrock Village, N11, Cabinteely Village and vice versa.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993, Temporary closure of Killiney Hill Road, Killiney

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Killiney Hill Road**, Killiney in order to facilitate Irish Water, Watermain Rehabilitation Works and Road Maintenance Road Surfacing Works.

Killiney Hill Road will be closed from the junction of Victoria Road to the junction of Military Road from

Monday, 5th July 2021 to Friday, 10th September 2021

and is proposing to close Killiney Hill Road in three phases in order to facilitate works and to minimise disruption to traffic, local residents and local businesses.

The three road closure phases are listed as follows:

1. Junction of Killiney Avenue to Military Road
2. Junction of Strathmore Road to Killiney Avenue
3. Junction of Victoria Road to Strathmore Road

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the works.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CORRIG ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Corrig Road** from its junction with Mulgrave Street to its junction with Glenageary Road Lower/Eden Road Upper. The closure will run from **Monday, 29th March 2021 to Friday, 6th August 2021**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Vesey Place, Monkstown ***

Concrete bin base installation works will commence during the week of Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 for one-day, between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Pedestrian footpath will be closed for 3-hours.

Traffic flows will not be impinged upon.

» **Wyckham Way, Dundrum ***

Minor concrete bin base installation works will commence during the week of Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 for one-day, between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Cycle Lane will be closed for 3-hours.

Traffic flows will not be impinged upon.

» **Roebuck Road, Clonskeagh - outside Mosque ***

Carriageway box and road crossing works will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 08:00 and 23:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Stop / Go System will be in operation.

» **Tullyvale Road at the Junction/entrance to Tullyvale/Druid Valley Estate ****

Upgrade works which involves the widening of the existing Tullyvale Road to an overall width of 25.0m will continue until Friday, 2nd July 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Tullyvale Road at the Junction/entrance to Tullyvale/Druid Valley Estate **** **(Day/Night Works)**

(24 hours per day excluding period from 4pm each Friday to 8am each Monday)

Complete the raising, levelling, and setting of road gully covers and manhole covers to finish road level for wearing course tarmac will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 16th July 2021.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Haddington Road and Albert Road Upper**

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are implementing a Stop / Go System on Tuesday, 22nd June 2021 until Wednesday, 23rd June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation

» **Leopardstown Road, Leopardstown ****

Gully Cleaning and Road Sweeping works will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management System will be in operation.

» **Churchtown Road Lower, Churchtown ****

Road patching works will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Wedgewood Estate, Ballinteer **
Cedar Road (The Apples and The Plumbs)**

Road patching works will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Victoria Terrace, Dundrum – off Dundrum Road **
(Entrance at Apache Pizza)**

Road patching works will commence on Monday, 21st June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Kilmacud Road Upper (Holywell to Sydenham Road) *

Patching roadworks will continue until Friday, 25th **June** 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer **

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment but a new footpath layout has been implemented and will be maintained for a number of weeks until the remaining dangerous wall is resolved.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Castle Park Road, Dalkey **

Pedestrian improvement works will continue for 6-8 weeks between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Sandyford Cycle Route ** (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road)

Provision of footpaths, two-way cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works. Project works will continue until mid - June 2021.

Traffic Management measures will be in operation at the following locations until further notice:

- all approaches to the junction of Kilgobbin Road / Hillcrest Road.
- hard shoulder closed on Drummartin Link Road between Blackthorn Drive and J14 M50 Rotary.

Junction Braemor Road and Churchtown Road Upper **

Telecom/Civil footpath works will commence on Monday, 14th June 2021 until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Saval Park Road, Dalkey **

Essential road restoration and associated works will continue until Friday, 25th June 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop/ Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Roundabout at R829 Glenageary Road Upper **

Telecom/Civil footpath works will continue until Friday, 30th June 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Road (N11) ** (+ Night works)

Terra Solutions Ltd. commenced works, to carry out CCTV survey of the stormwater drainage, on Stillorgan Road N11 on Tuesday, 4th May 2021 and will continue until Friday, 30th June 2021 between:

- 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. for the day works.
- 20:00 to 23:00 hrs. for the night works generate noise.
- 20:00 to 06:00 hrs. for the night works do not generate noise.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballinteer Avenue, Ballinteer **

Footpath works will continue until Friday, 16th July 2021 between 09:30 and 16:30 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Albert Road, St. Catherine's Road Junction, Dalkey **

Pedestrian improvement works will continue until mid-July 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 ** (between Brewery Road Junction and Kilmacud Lower Junction) Intermittent.

Upgrading Public Lighting Columns, Lanterns and associated Civil Works commenced on Tuesday, 6th April 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. (19:00 – 00:00 if required) for approximately 3-months - (end-July 2021).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Corrig Road, Dún Laoghaire – (24-hour Road Closure) ***

A 24-hour Road Closure will be in place on **Corrig Road** from its junction with Mulgrave Terrace to its Junction with Glenageary Road Lower from:

Monday, 29th March 2021 until **Friday, 6th August 2021**

to facilitate essential Road / Footpath Restoration and associated works.

- A ONE-WAY SYSTEM will be in operation on Corrig Road between the Junctions of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace and Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- There will be NO ACCESS to Corrig Road from the Junction of Glenageary Road Upper/Corrig Road. Diversion will be in place to direct vehicles around to the Junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace for access to one-way system.
- LOCAL ACCESS will be maintained via the junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace.
- LOCAL EGRESS will be maintained via the junction of Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- Access to Corrig Park, Corrig Avenue, Clarinda Park West, Crosthwaite Park and Royal Terrace will be via the one-way system gaining access from Tivoli Road /Mulgrave Terrace Junction.
- When exiting Corrig Park, Corrig Ave and Clarinda Park East, there will be NO Right Turn onto Corrig Road. Egress is via Left turn towards Corrig Road /Glenageary Road Junction.
- When Exiting Royal Terrace and Crosthwaite Park, there will be NO left turn in place. Egress is via Right hand turn towards Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Junction.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches.
- Traffic Management Arrangements will remain in place overnight for the duration of the works.
