PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Library Road, Shankill

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has received an application from Earlsfort Homes Ltd., 16, Lower Hatch Street, Dublin 2 to temporarily close **Library Road, Shankill** from the junction of Stonebridge Road/Library Road 100m from the junction down Library Road.

Monday 12th July 2021 to Friday 13th August 2021

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained.at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate *Surface Water Works* as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993. Temporary Closure of Leslie Avenue, Dalkey.

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close **Leslie Avenue** in order to facilitate footpath and road repairs and associated works. Leslie Avenue will be closed from its junction with Harbour Road to its junction with Coliemore Road from **Thursday 5th August 2021 to Friday 3rd September 2021.**

There will no through road on Leslie Avenue from Harbour Road to Coliemore Road.

Access and Egress to Harbour Road, Bullock Harbour, Beulah Court, Rock Lands, Harbour Crescent, Lorreto Avenue and any private roads will be maintained via the junction of Harbour Road and Ulverton Road.

Access to Leslie Avenue will be restricted to local residents only.

While every effort will be made to complete works during the hours 08:00hrs and 18:00hrs, Monday to Friday, there may be times works are permitted to be undertaken at weekends and/or at evening/night (Surfacing Works Only).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation. Local access will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrianisation of George's St. Lower, Dún Laoghaire

As part of Dún Laoghaire Summer Streets initiative, a pedestrianisation of Georges Street Lower from the junction with Marine Road through to St Michael's Hospital/Myrtle Square will be in place from Monday, 5th July 2021 until Thursday, 30th September 2021. Vehicular access will be prohibited with loading only provided up until 11am.

There will be a week's work to install the antiskid surfacing, planters, street furniture etc starting Monday 5th July 2021 at 11am with night works are undertaken between 19:00 and 05:00.

The pedestrianised zone will be marshalled at both ends at all times

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes will be signed.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary closure of Claremont Road, Dublin 18

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Claremont Road** between Brighton Road/ Brennanstown Road junction up to and including Kerrymount Avenue Roundabout from

Monday 5th July 2021 to Saturday 31st July 2021

inclusive -to facilitate Claremont Road Upgrade Works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will always be maintained.

Diversion routes will be Foxrock Village, N11, Cabinteely Village and vice versa.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary closure of Killiney Hill Road, Killiney

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily

close **Killiney Hill Road**, Killiney to facilitate Irish Water Watermain

Rehabilitation Works and Road Maintenance Road Surfacing Works.

Killiney Hill Road will be closed from the junction of Victoria Road to the junction of Military Road from

Monday, 5th July 2021 to Friday, 10th September 2021.

It is proposed to close Killiney Hill Road in three phases to facilitate works and to minimise disruption to traffic, residents, and local businesses.

The three road closure phases are listed as follows:

- 1. Junction of Killiney Avenue to Military Road
- 2. Junction of Strathmore Road to Killiney Avenue
- 3. Junction of Victoria Road to Strathmore Road

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the works.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Corrig Road, Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to

temporarily close **Corrig Road** from its junction with Mulgrave Street to its junction with Glenageary Road Lower/Eden Road Upper. The closure will run from

Monday, 29th March 2021 to Friday, 6th August 2021

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will always be maintained. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

» Newtownpark Avenue (at Stillorgan Road) ***

Traffic works will commence at the junction with Newtownpark Avenue at the junction with Stillorgan Road during the week commencing Monday 28th June 2021 for 6-8 weeks

The work consists of traffic lane realignment, removal of a bus lane and cycle improvements. Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Station Road, Glenageary ***

Pedestrian improvement works will commence on Station Road at the junction with Marlborough Road (near the Dart Station) during the week commencing Monday 28th June 2021 for 4-6 weeks

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Albert Road, St. Catherine's Road junction, Dalkey ***

Pedestrian improvement works will commence at the junction of Albert Road and St Catherine's Road during the week commencing Monday 31st

May for 4 -6 weeks. Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Castlepark Road Dalkey ***

Pedestrian improvement works at junctions will commence on Castlepark Road during the week commencing Tuesday 6th April 2021 until the end of July 2021

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Saval Park Road, Dalkey **

Snagging and associated works will commence on Saval Park Road, during the week commencing Monday 28th June 2021 to Friday, 9th July 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop/ Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Haddington Road and Albert Road Upper **

Sandyford Cycle Route ** (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road)

Provision of footpaths, two-way cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works. Project works will continue until **31**st **July 2021**.

Traffic Management measures will be in operation at the following locations until further notice:

- all approaches to the junction of Kilgobbin Road / Hillcrest Road.
- hard shoulder closed on Drummartin Link Road between Blackthorn Drive and J14 M50 Rotary.

Corrig Road, Dún Laoghaire – (24-hour Road Closure) ***

A 24-hour Road Closure will be in place on Corrig Road from its junction with Mulgrave Terrace to its Junction with Glenageary Road Lower from

Monday, 29th March 2021 until Friday, 6th August 2021

to facilitate essential Road / Footpath Restoration and associated works.

- A ONE-WAY SYSTEM will be in operation on Corrig Road between the Junctions of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace and Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- There will be NO ACCESS to Corrig Road from the Junction of Glenageary Road Upper/Corrig Road. Diversion will be in place to direct vehicles around to the Junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace for access to one-way system.
- LOCAL ACCESS will be maintained via the junction of Tivoli Road/Mulgrave Terrace.
- LOCAL EGRESS will be maintained via the junction of Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Upper.
- Access to Corrig Park, Corrig Avenue, Clarinda Park West, Crosthwaite Park and Royal Terrace will be via the one-way system gaining access from Tivoli Road /Mulgrave Terrace Junction.
- When exiting Corrig Park, Corrig Ave and Clarinda Park East, there will be NO Right Turn onto Corrig Road. Egress is via Left turn towards Corrig Road /Glenageary Road Junction.
- When Exiting Royal Terrace and Crosthwaite Park, there will be NO left turn in place. Egress is via Right hand turn towards Corrig Road/Glenageary Road Junction.
- Works will be undertaken during the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.
- Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches.
- Traffic Management Arrangements will remain in place <u>overnight</u> for the duration of the works
