

Guideline Wording for Newspaper Notice

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council

The planning application may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy at the offices of the Planning Authority, County Hall, Dún Laoghaire during its public opening hours.

A submission/observation may be made on payment of €20 within a period of 5 weeks from the date the application is received by the planning authority.

- 1. Insert whether for permission, outline permission, permission consequent on the grant of outline permission (state reg. ref. of outline permission here) or retention of development.*
- 2. The nature and extent of the development proposed (eg. number of houses) and whether it involves the demolition of a building specified in class 50 (a)(i), (ii), (iii) of schedule 2 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001.*
- 3. Postal address or townland of the structure or the location of the land.*
- 4. Name of applicant.*

The newspaper notice should also state if the application is:

- (a) accompanied by an E.I.S. and that it will be available at the office of the planning authority;*
- (b) if the application relates to a protected structure and/or its curtilage.*
