Who can apply?

The scheme is open to groups operating in the Community & Voluntary sector who have an open and representative structure, (preferably with a legal basis) operates on a "not for profit" basis establish a policy of inclusion and demonstrates the capacity to deliver the proposed project.

Level of grant aid available

Funding is on a competitive basis at a rate of up to 100% of the total eligible costs of the training project/programme. The following table provides a guide to the available budget and the level of funding available for this [funding call](#).
