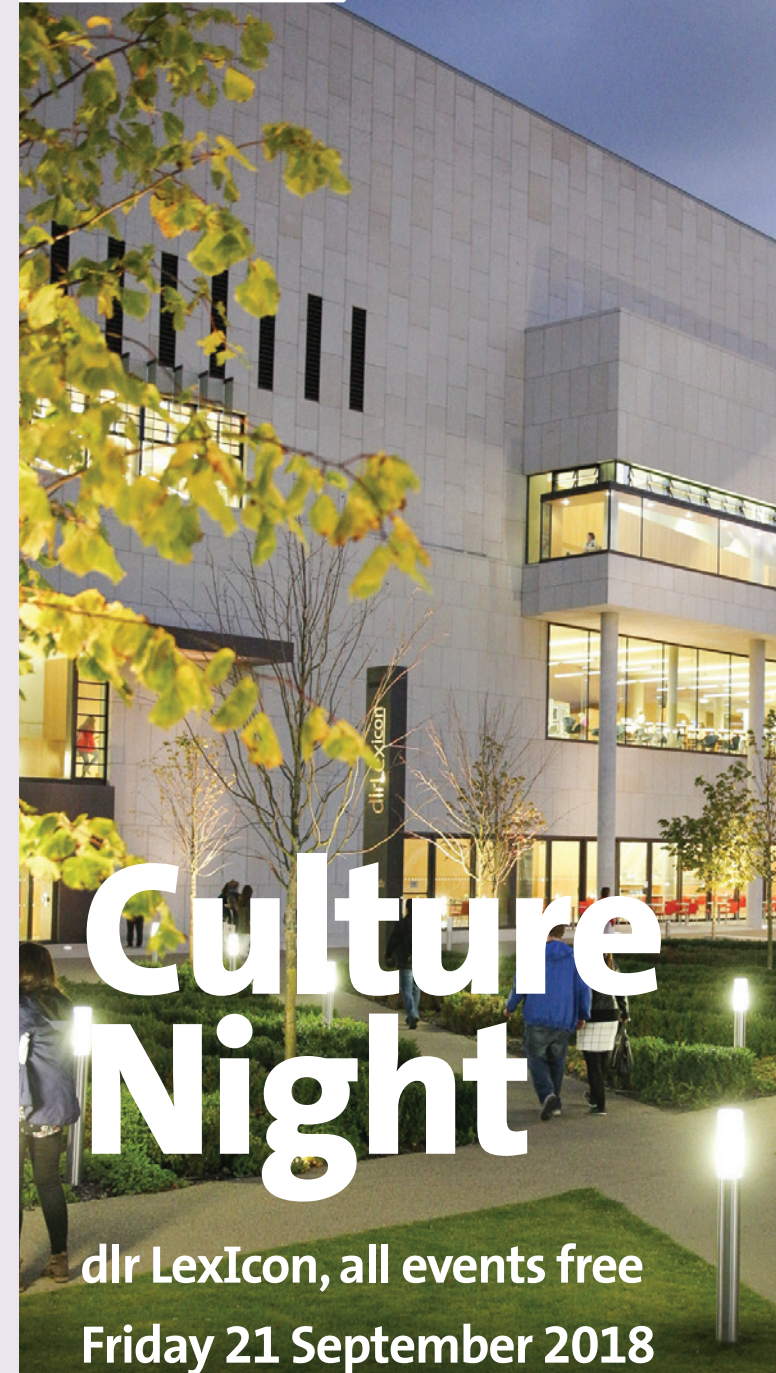

In September 2017, Music Generation dlr was selected for participation in Music Generation, Ireland's national performance music education programme initiated by Music Network and co-funded by U2, The Ireland Funds and the Department of Education and Skills and Local Music Education Partnerships. Locally, Music Generation dlr is managed by dlr Music Education Partnership (MEP), led by dlr County Council in partnership with Dublin and Dún Laoghaire Education and Training Board, TUSLA, Southside Partnership dlr, Blackrock Education Centre, IADT, UCD and Crosscare.

Music Generation dlr will begin the implementation of programmes for children and young people across the county of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown, commencing in September 2018.
