LA 4: Archives of Kingstown/Dun Laoghaire

The records of Kingstown/Dun Laoghaire date from 1834 when the township was established by the Kingstown Improvement Act. The collection contains a number of abstracts of existing minutes which have been retained because the brief comments therein by the presiding Chairman or Township Secretary provide additional insights into the workings of the authority. Also included are: a report book by the Medical Officer of Health 1922-1929 (LA 4/117); a Resgiser of Notification of Infectious Disease 1902-1931 (LA 4/118); two pamphlets on the public health and climate of Kingstown 1881-1884 (LA 4/329); and a damp-press copy book of the Kingstown Life-Boat Disaster Trust 1897-1902 (LA 4/302).

A MINUTES

2 September 1834 - 7 October 1930

Proceedings of monthly, annual and special meetings of Kingstown Township Commissioners and Urban District Council from the Commissioner's inception in 1834 pursuant to the Kingstown Improvement Act, 1834, entitled an "Act for the paving, watching, lighting, regulating and otherwise improving the town of Kingstown". Minutes record attendance, resolutions, correspondence, the formation of standing and sub-committees, the presentation of their minutes and reports, the appointment of town surveyor, nuisance, later sanitary inspector and the medical officer of health with discussions and decisions in relation to same, the examination of accounts, raising of loans, striking of rates, adoption of estimates, awarding of contracts, preparation of bye-laws and implementation of lighting, housing, road and drainage improvement schemes.
