

# Old Connaught- Woodbrook Water Supply Scheme

02 November 2022

Irish Water is upgrading drinking water infrastructure to safeguard the drinking water supply for Southeast Dublin and North Wicklow.



Irish Water, working in partnership with Dun Laoghaire Rathdown and Wicklow County Councils, is upgrading the drinking water infrastructure supplying the Old Connaught-Woodbrook Water Supply Scheme. This project involves the construction of strategic reservoir storage and associated water mains connections to provide network resilience and flexibility for Southeast Dublin (Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council) and parts of North County Wicklow.

The current drinking water infrastructure in the area is inadequate and the works will involve the construction of two state of the art new reservoirs and approximately 13km of new watermains. Ward and Burke Construction Limited is delivering this project on behalf of Irish Water.


Once completed, this project will improve the security of drinking water supply in the area and benefit homes and businesses, as well as supporting future development in the area. The completed project will serve approximately 13,600 existing customers and will cater for projected growth up to approximately 46,700 customers.

Works are now starting on site and upcoming works are outlined below:

## Details of upcoming Road Closures:

### Section of Road: Ferndale Road

The purposes of the road closure is to facilitate the installation of new watermains along Ferndale Road.

**Duration:** 4 months



## Road closure phasing:

In Order to minimise impact the road closure will be closed off in sections.

There will be 5 phases to the closure.

## **Frequently Asked Questions In Relation To Road Closures....**

### **Homes Adjacent To The Road Closure**

#### **1. Will I be able to access my home?**

Yes, pedestrian access will be maintained to your home at all times. There will be restrictions on parking for locals along the pipeline route, however, the contractor will liaise and assist directly with all residents.

#### **2. Will the Emergency Services be able to access my home?**

The emergency services have been notified of the road closure, with maps provided, allowing them to manage their response should an emergency arise. Emergency services manage road closures on a regular basis. They will include the road closure info into their dispatching protocol. They will determine how best to deploy a service, be it an ambulance, fire truck or Garda car. The road closure will not impact the quality of service being provided by the Emergency services.

#### **3. Will refuse collection services be able to access the area?**

Where works are impacting on the collection, bins will be pulled to an access point at the end of the works by the contractor to facilitate collection and returned after collection.

#### **4. Will the services to my house such as water, gas, electricity be affected?**

It is not envisaged that there will be any impact to services. However if any water shut off are required 48 hours' notice will be given to all home owners and businesses owners.

#### **5. Parking?**

All residents directly impacted by the works will be contacted and liaised with in relation to same.

Local secondary schools have been notified on the upcoming works.

School buses will also be notified of upcoming works and diversions from the schools.


