

Active School Travel - School Classroom Travel Survey 2021

As part of our ongoing Active School Travel initiative, the Council is inviting all schools in the County to take part in a School Classroom Travel Survey, proposed to take place on the morning of Wednesday 19th May 2021.

The overall aim of Active School Travel is to support and promote various active means for children to get to school in a safe and active way, with a focus on walking and cycling. The goal is to reduce car congestion around schools by making it possible for more pupils to walk and cycle to school, alone or with adult supervision.

In order to monitor if the measures to be implemented in 2021 as part of the Active School Travel initiative have the desired effect, we need to understand the current travel baseline i.e. the number of children walking and cycling to school at present. As such, we are inviting all schools to take part on the Schools Classroom Travel Survey 2021.
