» **Section 75, Roads Act, 1993**
Temporary Road Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application to temporarily close **Castle Street** from The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey to Allied Irish Bank on **Saturday 24th August, 2019** and **Sunday 25th August, 2019** from **11 a.m.** to **7.00 p.m.** in order to facilitate **Dalkey Lobster Festival**.

The purpose of the closure is to create a safe and family friendly community atmosphere for **the Lobster Festival with Cookery Demonstrations, Street Entertainment etc.**

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Hillcrest Road, Sandyford

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close Hillcrest Road, Sandyford, from the junction of Kilgobbin Road to the junction with Enniskerry Road from **Monday 19th August to Friday 23rd August 2019 inclusive**, between **9.00 a.m.** and **5.00 p.m.**

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road patching and safety improvement works on Hillcrest Road by the dlr Roads Maintenance Section.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion route will be clearly sign-posted. Access to Sandyford Village / Sandyford Road from Kilgobbin Road will be unaffected. Local access to Hillcrest Road will be maintained.

Diversion of traffic will be via Killgobbin Road and Enniskerry Road and vice versa.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, Wicklow County Council and South Dublin County Council are considering the temporary closure of the following roads to facilitate the **Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019** event which will take place on **Sunday, 25th August 2019.**

The Ironman 70.3 Triathlon 2019 will involve a 1.2 mile swim, 56 mile cycle and 13.1 mile run. The swim will take place early morning in Scotsman's Bay, Dún Laoghaire, followed by a cycle from Dún Laoghaire that will head to Kiltarnan, then south through Enniskerry to Roundwood, turning west to the Sally Gap, then north through Glencree to Cruagh Road before turning east back through Glencullen and Kiltarnan to Dun Laoghaire. The run will then take place in Dun Laoghaire along the seafront.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 DLR Bay 10K Road Race

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council have made an order to temporarily close the roads listed below on **Monday 5th August, 2019** in order to facilitate a **10K Road Race**.

The race will take the following route:

Newtownsmith, Windsor Terrace, Queen's Road, Crofton Road, Harbour Road, Dun Leary Road, Longford Terrace, Seapoint Ave, Seafield Ave, Monkstown Road, Carrickbrennan Road, Mounttown Upper, Mounttown Lower, Upper Glenageary Road, Albert Road Upper, Albert Road, St. Catherine's Road, Castle Park Road, Elton Park, Sandycove Road, Glathule Road, and Link Road.

Newtownsmith, Windsor Terrace, Queen's Road, Crofton Road, and Harbour Road will be closed from **06.00 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.** and the remaining roads will be subject to a rolling closure as the race progresses between **9.50 a.m. – 12.30 p.m.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversions will be signposted.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Adelaide Road

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS
14 to 17 Southbound
SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, has made an order in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 to temporarily close:

- The M50 Southbound between Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire) and Junction 17 (M11 merge).

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for each phase of the works. Phase 4 of works will mainly take place on the N31 (Blackrock to Dún Laoghaire) and also on the N11. Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

George's Avenue and Blackrock Main Street (part of) ***

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 29th July 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Rosmeen Gardens, Dún Laoghaire **

Footpath restoration works will commence on Tuesday, 6th August 2019 until Friday, 23rd August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Stillorgan Road, Stillorgan *

Excavation works for sewer connection works on public footpath outside 409 Stillorgan Road (next to Talbot Hotel), Stillorgan, Co. Dublin with concrete footpath reinstatement works will commence on Monday, 29th July 2019 until Friday, 9th August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Killiney Road, Killiney ***

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 22nd July 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Brennanstown Road, Foxrock – new Residential Development ***

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 15th November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of north and south bound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and south bound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion *September 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane – north bound carriageway only) ***

Works commenced on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until *autumn 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Deansgrange Road
3. Mounttown Road
4. Abbey Road
5. Clonskeagh Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. York Road

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **August**, internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.

Valeview Avenue, The Park Cabinteely *

Surfacing overlay works commenced on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.
