


DLRCC TRAFFIC NEWS

Listed below are noteworthy road works of which the Traffic and Road Safety Section has been informed. Details are supplied as per information received by 16:00 hrs. on the preceding Thursday. Emergency road works cannot be forecast.



ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 2 of 2019 on the N11 Dual Carriageway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the construction of the new signalised junction on the N11 at Cabinteely, south of the Johnstown Road junction, has made an Order entitled "Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2019 on the **N11 Dual Carriageway** in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown" to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

The Special Speed Limit of 60 km/hr will be valid for the N11 Southbound and Northbound and will run from 07/10/2019 until 01/03/2020 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

The location of the special speed limit will be for part of the Southbound and Northbound carriageways of the N11 between a point 425 metres South of the existing junction of the N11 with Johnstown Road, to a point 1015 metres North of the R118 overbridge (at the junction of N11 / Wyattville Road). The length of road subject to this speed limit is 400m.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

Kilcross Estate- The Court Sandyford *

Footpath works will commence on Monday, 9th December, 2019 until Friday, 20th December 2019 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Diversion Route Review – Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Lane ** (Night works)

Supply and Installation of Road Traffic Signs commenced on Wednesday, 11th December 2019 and will be completed by Tuesday 17th December 2019. The works will take place between 19:00 to 23:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Queen's Road at Dún Laoghaire Harbour **

Footpath works will commence on Monday,6th January 2020 until Friday, 11th January 2020 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes, and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely.

Works in the Median will begin from 7th October and will continue to end January 2020.

2 lanes in both directions will be maintained, and as the lanes will be narrowed, a Special Speed Limit of **60km/hr** will apply for the duration of the works in the median.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and the traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction during the night work.

Avoca Road, Blackrock ***

New storm / foul connection works for Glensavage Development will continue until Friday, 20^{th} December 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop & Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works *** (Night works)

Lining works on the cycle track at Junctions Oakdown/Whitebarn/Meadow Park Avenue and Nutgrove Way + will continue until Friday, 20^{th} December 2019 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballinclea Road, Killiney ***

Road restoration and associated works will be undertaken on Ballinclea Road during the week commencing Monday, 2nd December 2019 for duration of 3-weeks between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Westminster Road – Mart Lane to Gordon Avenue **

Bitimous footpath repairs will commence on Monday, 25th November 2019 until Tuesday, 17th December 2019 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by mid-2020.

During **December**, internal construction of the building will be completed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Cunningham Drive, Dalkey **

Road restoration works will continue until Friday, 20^{th} December 2019 between 09:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Temporary Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Rochestown Avenue at the National Rehabilitation Hospital *** (Day and Night works)

Civil works associated with the National Rehabilitation Hospital will continue until Friday, 31st January 2020 – 24hours / 7 days per week.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until <u>April 2020</u>.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will continue until commence on: Monday, 16th September 2019 on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Killiney Road
- 3. Tivoli Road
- 4. Avondale Road
- 5. Ballinclea Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Vico Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until Friday, 20th December 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on 2nd September 2019 and run <u>for 16 consecutive weeks</u>. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace commenced on 2nd September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.
