PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council is proposing to close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Upper Kilmacud Road to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from 13:00 hrs to 18:00 hrs. on Sunday 26th June 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.

A traffic management plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted.

Local access will be maintained at all times.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT, MEADOW CLOSE, MEADOW
VILLAS AND MEADOW GROVE**

Orwell Wheelers has requested the temporary closure of Meadowmount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The closure is to take place from 18:30 . on Wednesday, 22nd June 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A traffic management plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 BOOTERSTOWN-KILMACUD LR
ROAD(NORTH AND SOUTH BOUND) - Night Works****

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close N11 Booterstown-Kilmacud Road Lower from Monday 11th April 2022 to Friday 6th May 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Planning, Resurfacing, Line Marking and Raising of Iron Works.

» **SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 *****
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACKGLEN ROAD,
SANDYFORD, DUBLIN 18

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council made an order to temporarily close Blackglen Road between the two Junctions with Ticknock Park and Simonsridge from Monday 28th February 2022 to Monday 5th September 2022.

A number of submissions were received in relation to the proposed road closure. These submissions have been considered and the road closure is approved with amended dates, and mitigation measures in place. **The road closure will be in place from Monday 28th March 2022 to Monday 3rd October 2022.**

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate road works as part of the Blackglen Road improvement scheme.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The proposed diversion route will be via the Loop road and all residents access will be maintained.

A traffic management plan will be in place and the diversion will be clearly signposted.

SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the M50 Traffic Flow Optimisation Construction Project; has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

M50 Southbound will run from 07/02/2022 until 1st December 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 Overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 Overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).

- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper
(Total 575m in length).

M50 Northbound will run from 03 August 2021 until 01 November 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge
(Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge
(Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge
(Total 450m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16
(Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper
(Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15
(Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper
(Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13
(Total 480m in length).

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 80 km/hr on the M50 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

» **N11 Stillorgan Road Southbound from N11 Stillorgan Road/ N31 Mount Merrion Road Intersection to Lower Kilmacud Road ** (Night Works)**

Raising of ironworks and high friction surfacing will commence on the northbound lanes of the N11 Stillorgan Road from the junction with the N31 Mount Merrion Avenue to the junction with Lower Kilmacud Road. The works will commence on Monday 16th May 2022 and are expected to be complete by Saturday 21st May 2022. The works will take place between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

» **356 Nutgrove Avenue, Churchtown, D14 ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out drinking water upgrade works to the network, between 09:00 and 18:00 hrs, Thursday 19th May 2022 to Friday 20th May 2022.

A stop go system will be in operation.

»Church of Good Shepherd, Nutgrove Avenue **

A stop go system will be in operation.

» Pine Valley Estate, Rathfarnham ***

A traffic management plan will be in place.

»Sandyford Road beside Lamb's Brook **

Virgin Media Ireland are installing a road crossing for a new development between Wednesday 18th May 2022 and Friday 20th May 2022. The works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

» Stillorgan Wood, Stillorgan***

Avondale Road **

Road reconstruction on Bellevue Road, Glenageary will continue between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. Works are scheduled to conclude by Wednesday 1st July 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Dublin Road, Shankill**

Replacement of public lighting columns will take place until Friday 27th May 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in operation.

#Sans Souci Park, Booterstown Avenue***

Concrete footpath restoration works will continue at this location between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs until Friday 20th of May 2022.

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer ***

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment. However, a new footpath layout has been implemented. This will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.
