ROAD CLOSURES

**Section 75 of the Road Act 1993-
Temporary Closure of Ardbrough Road, Dalkey*****

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities C/O Irish Water to temporarily close Ardbrough Road, from Torca Road to Dalkey Avenue with effect from Tuesday 23rd November 2021 to Wednesday 24th November 2021.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Sewer and Water Connections.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will always be maintained. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

**Section 75 of the Road Act 1993-
Temporary Closure of Mount Merrion Avenue***
(Night Works)**

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland to temporarily close Mount Merrion Avenue from the junction with Rock Road to the junction with Cross Avenue.

The closure will take place between 19:30 and 05:30 hrs from Tuesday 23rd November 2021 to Sunday 5th December 2021. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate planing and line marking works. These works will take place at night because of high traffic volumes during the day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

SPEED LIMIT ORDER

**Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50
Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown**

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the M50 Traffic Flow Optimisation Construction Project; has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

M50 Northbound will run from 03 August 2021 until 31 March 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of Speed Limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).

- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

M50 Southbound will run from 01 November 2021 until 31 October 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 Overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 Overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 480m in length).

- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 575m in length).

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention **to decrease the Speed Limit to 80 km/hr** on the **M50** Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Coliemore Road, Dalkey **

Road reconstruction works Coliemore Road, Dalkey will take place on Monday 22nd November 2021 and Tuesday 23rd November 2021 from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs.

» N11 – (Leopardstown outbound to Cherrywood junction) ***

Weed removal and cleaning of traffic islands will take place on Saturday 20th November 2021 and Sunday 21st November 2021 between 05:00 and 14:00 hrs.

All works on the fast lane will be concluded by 10:00 hrs.

Traffic flows controlled with cones and IPV.

Fast Lane to be vacated by 10am and thereafter works limited to hard shoulder/bus lane.

Belarmine Avenue, Stepside **

Road reconstruction works on Belarmine Avenue, Stepside is scheduled to continue until Friday 10th December 2021. The works will take place from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs.

Farrenboley Park, Dundrum ***

Pedestrian improvement works consisting of build-outs to footpaths will continue Friday 3rd December 2021 between the times of 10:00 to 16:00 hrs.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management System will be in place. Temporary traffic lights will also be set up at certain phrases of the works.

George's Place and Kelly's Avenue, Dún Laoghaire **

Road reconstruction works and minor footpath reconstruction works will continue until Friday, 26th November 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 – (UCD to Leopardstown outbound) ***

Weed removal and cleaning of traffic islands commenced on Saturday 13th November 2021 for 2-3 weekends between 05:00 and 14:00 hrs. The works are scheduled to run until Sunday 28th November 2021.

All works on the fast lane will be concluded by 10:00 hrs.

Traffic flows controlled with cones and IPV.

Fast Lane to be vacated by 10am and thereafter works limited to hard shoulder/bus

Rathsallagh Grove, Shankill **

Road resurfacing works on Rathsallagh Grove will continue until Friday, 26th November 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

Also, the CCTV Survey of Gullies and associated main line drainage systems will continue within Rathsallagh Estate.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

St Helens Road, Booterstown **

Footpath reconstruction works commenced on St Helens Road will continue until Friday 10th December 2021. The works will take place from 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

Works which will require Traffic Management on Rock Road will be restricted between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Ulverton Road, Dalkey **

Road reconstruction works and minor footpath reconstruction works will continue until Friday 3rd December 2021. The works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Woodpark Estate, (The Heights), Ballinteer **

Pedestrian crossing and footpath repairs will continue until Friday, 26th November 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Albert Road/St. Catherine's Road, Glenageary ***

Junction improvement works will continue until end of November 2021.

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer ***

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment but a new footpath layout has been implemented and will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Blackglan Road Improvement Scheme ***

Murphy International Ltd. has been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to carry out the construction of this scheme.

Traffic Management will be in place from October 2021 at various locations along Blackglan Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

The construction stage of the scheme will last for approximately 18 months (April 2023).

Updates to this notice will be provided as the works progress.

Castlepark Road, Dalkey **

Pedestrian improvement works will continue until end of November 2021.

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place

Glencairn View - on green Area opposite Glencairn View, Murphystown, Leopardstown *

Construction of new shared cycleway in the green area opposite Glencairn View by Park Developments will continue until Monday, 23rd December 2021 between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 – Monday to Friday.

Pedestrian Management Plan will be in place throughout construction phases.

Kilcross - off Sandyford Road **

Footpath repairs will continue until Friday, 26th November 2021 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Murphystown Way, Sandyford ***

Road and path works will continue until Saturday, 4th December 2021 between the times of 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. The purpose of these works is to create a signalised junction for a new residential development.

The location of the works is between the junction for the Glencairn Development and the traffic light junction at Leopardstown Road, close to the Glencairn Luas stop.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

N11 – (Loughlinstown to White’s Cross inbound and outbound) ***

Weed removal and cleaning of traffic islands commenced on Saturday, 23rd October 2021 for 4-5 weekends between 05:00 and 14:00 hrs. The works are due to conclude on Sunday 21st November 2021.

Traffic flows will be controlled with cones and IPV.

Fast Lane to be vacated by 10:00 hrs and thereafter works limited to hard shoulder/bus lane

Other weekends will affect different facets of the road and Cleansing will flag each facet as it occurs.

N11 **

(between Brewery Road Junction and Kilmacud Lower Junction) Intermittent

Upgrading Public Lighting Columns, Lanterns and associated Civil Works commenced on Tuesday, 6th April 2021 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. (19:00 – 00:00 if required) and will continue until Friday, 17th December 2021.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Overend Way, Dundrum ***

(Night Works)

Work on the removal of cycle tracks road markings and the installation of extra road markings will continue until end of November 2021.

Works will primarily be undertaken between 23:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place

Roebuck Road, Clonskeagh ***

Junction improvement works and footpath repairs on Roebuck Road will continue until Wednesday, 1st December 2021 at the following locations:

1. Louvain
2. The Palms
3. Roebuck Castle East
4. Roebuck Castle West
5. Harlech Downs

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Station Road, Glenageary ***

Pedestrian improvement works will continue on Station Road at the junction with Marlborough Road (near the Dart Station) until end of November 2021.

Works will primarily be undertaken between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Wyattville Dual Carriageway (between Church Road junction and Wyattville Road junction) ***

Public lighting upgrade works will continue until Friday, 17th December 2021 (intermittent) between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.
