ROAD CLOSURES

» **Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**
Temporary Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey ***
(Night Works)

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from its junction with Whites Villas to its junction with Convent Road from Monday 21st September, 2020 to Thursday 24th September, 2020 inclusive. Works will take place between 7pm and 6am.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate resurfacing of the Road Carriageway.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Casement Villas *

Footpath reconstruction works and resurfacing works to the parking area at Casement Villas from Tuesday 22nd Sept to Friday 25th Sept from 8am to 6pm.

There will be a traffic management system in place.

» Pakenham Road **

Road reconstruction works on Pakenham Road from Wednesday 23rd Sept to Friday 25th Sept from 8am to 8pm.

There will be a traffic management system in place.

» Junction of Kilmacud Road Upper and Sydenham Road ** (Night Works)

Road restoration works will commence Monday, 21st September 2020 until Friday 2nd October 2020 between 09:30 and 16:30 hrs. There will also be night works required between 07:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballyogan Road/Murphystown way ** (Night Works)

Renewal of cycle track road markings along Ballyogan Road until the end of September 2020 between 19:00 and 05:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place

» Myrtle Park , Dun Laogharie ***

Footpath restoration works will start during the week commencing Monday, 21st September 2020 until Friday, 9th October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Tullyvale Road at the junction to Druid Valley***

Installation of ducting works will start during the week commencing Monday, 21st September 2020 until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop and Go system will be in operation to allow one lane of traffic at all times.

Green Route Southbound- Dundrum to Sandyford*
(Night Works)**

Line marking, road kerb jetting and studding works will take place between Friday 18th September 2020 and Tuesday 29th September 2020 at Junction 13 southbound and Junction 14 southbound. which will result in lane closures. The works are scheduled to take place between 18:00 hrs and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Oakwood, Dun Laoghaire ***

Footpath restoration works will start during the week commencing Monday 21st September 2020 until Wednesday 23rd September 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue, Churchtown *
(Night Works)**

Installation of line markings will continue until Friday 25th September 2020 between 18:00 and 06:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Stillorgan Industrial Estate (Spruce Ave/Rowan Ave/Maple Ave) *

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 31th August 2020 and will continue until Friday, 2nd October 2020 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Goatstown Road *
(Night Works)**

Installation of delineation kerb for cycle lane will continue until late September 2020 between 19:00 and 05:00 hrs. Some night works will take place at the junction of Goatstown Road and Roebuck Road.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place

Stillorgan Road (UCD Access) Cycle Improvement Scheme ***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, relocated bus stops and associated works, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works recommenced on Monday, 18th May 2020 and will continue until 30th November 2020 between 08:00 and 20:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 – Southbound (between Stillorgan Park Junction and Brewery Road Junction) **

Upgrading of public lighting columns and lanterns.

Works will continue until Wednesday, 30th September 2020 (intermittent) from 10:00 to 16:00 hrs. and 19:30 to Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works.

Dalkey Village ***

Works commenced in Dalkey Village on Monday, 10th August 2020 and will continue for approximately 11-weeks between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Dundrum Village ***

DLR Traffic Section are installing a **One-Way System**, Northbound only, on Dundrum Main Street and on Sandyford Road for 140m from Dundrum Cross.

Access to Upper Kilmacud Road from Dundrum Cross will also be prohibited.

These measures are for an indefinite duration.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

During **September** the building will be made weather tight. Structural concrete walls, including sea walls will continue. Installation of pedestrian deck will commence. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace except for the delivery of materials, which will be short-term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Monday to Friday.

Wyattville Link Road, Cherrywood ***

Road works in the northern verge and central median of the Wyattville Link Road between Tullyvale and the M50 will continue until October 2020.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Enniskerry Road / Village Road Junction **

Removal of concrete footpath, installation of boundary wall, construction of new bus layby and reinstatement of new footpath commenced Monday, 10th August 2020 and will continue until Friday, 6th November 2020 between 08:00 to 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road Upper
8. Woodbine Road
9. Vico Road
10. Monkstown Road

These works will continue until 22nd December 2020.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Sandyford Cycle Route (Kilgobbin to Drummartin Link Road) ***

Provision of footpaths, two-way cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, new traffic signal layout and toucan crossing, street lighting, soft landscaping, utility provision and utility diversions and all associated works. Project works will continue until **May 2021**.

Traffic Management measures will be in operation at the following locations until further notice:

- all approaches to the junction of Drummartin Link Road and Blackthorn Drive
- all approaches to Junction 14 - M50 Rotary
- hard shoulder closed on Drummartin Link Road between Blackthorn Drive and J14 M50 Rotary.
