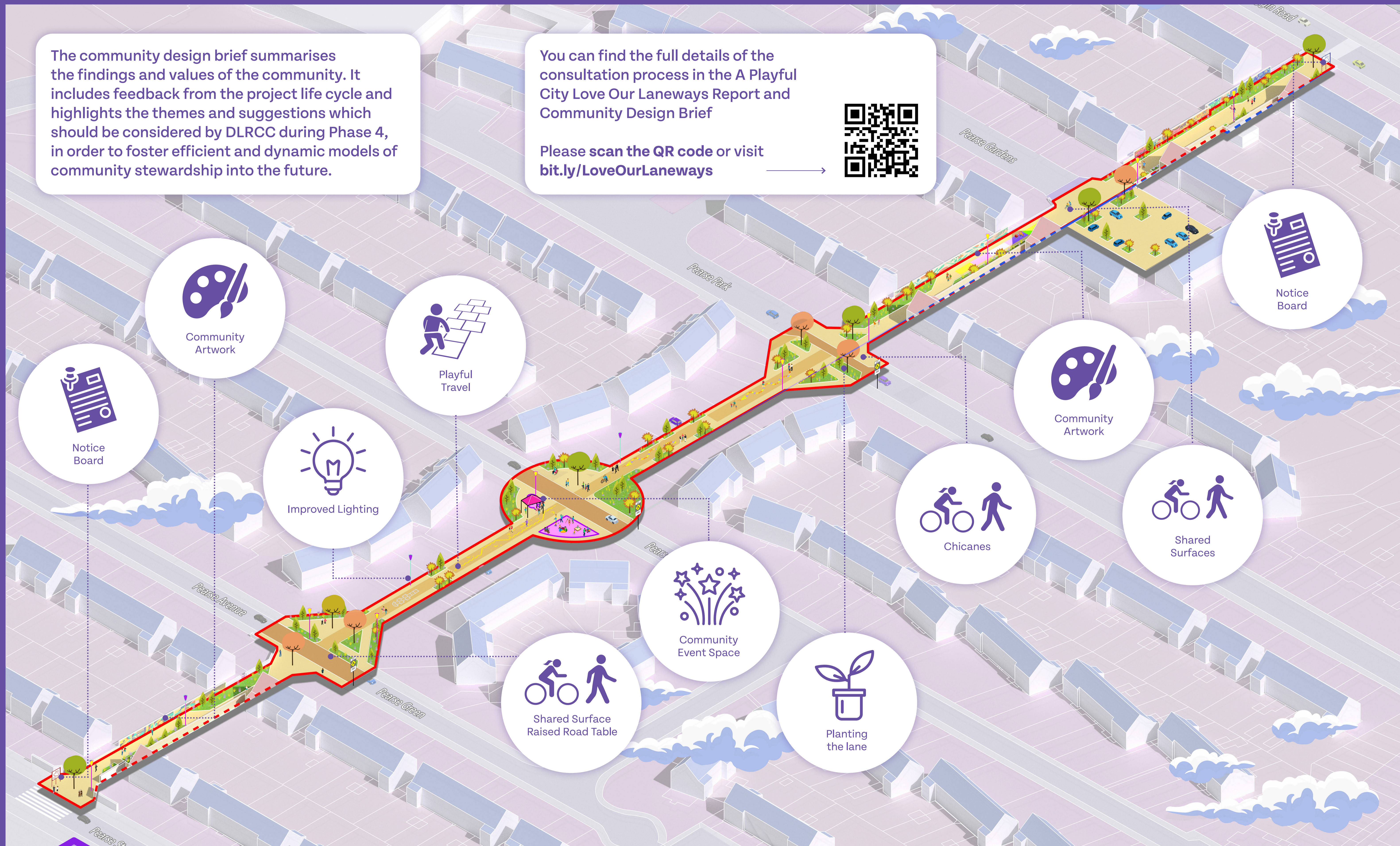

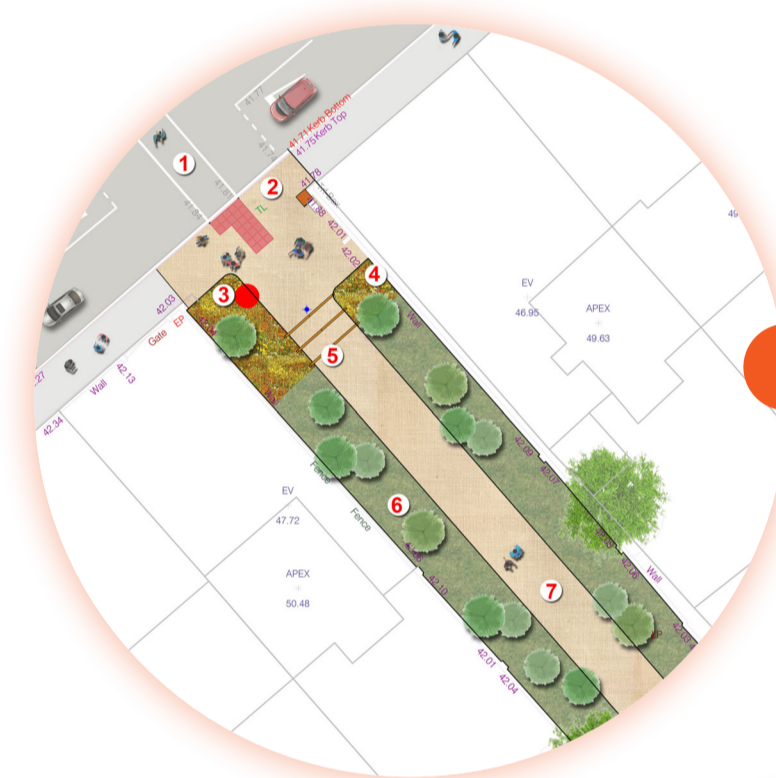

We are delighted to show you some surface treatments by artist Kinmx for the laneway.

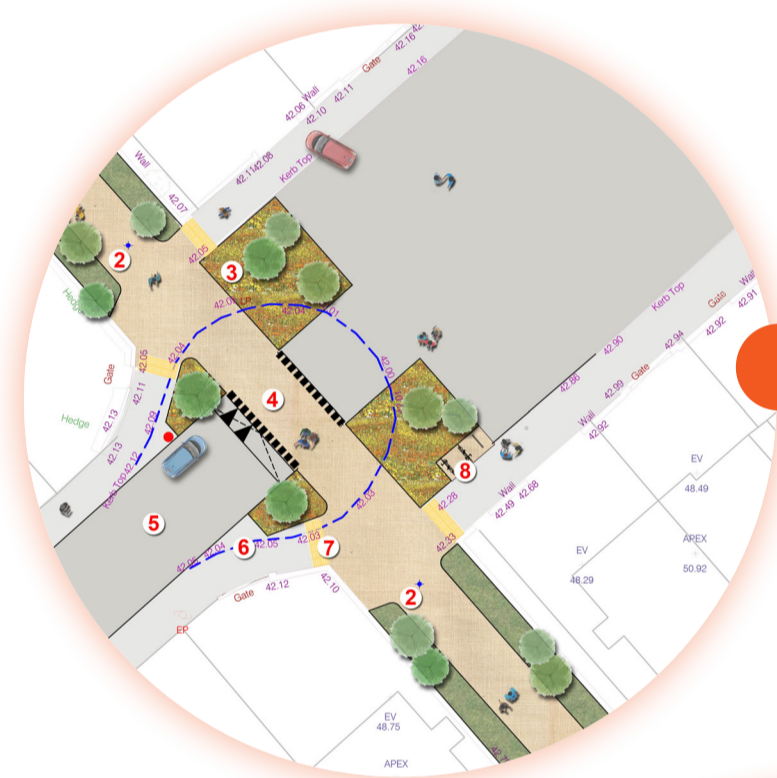
There are 4 types of surface treatment

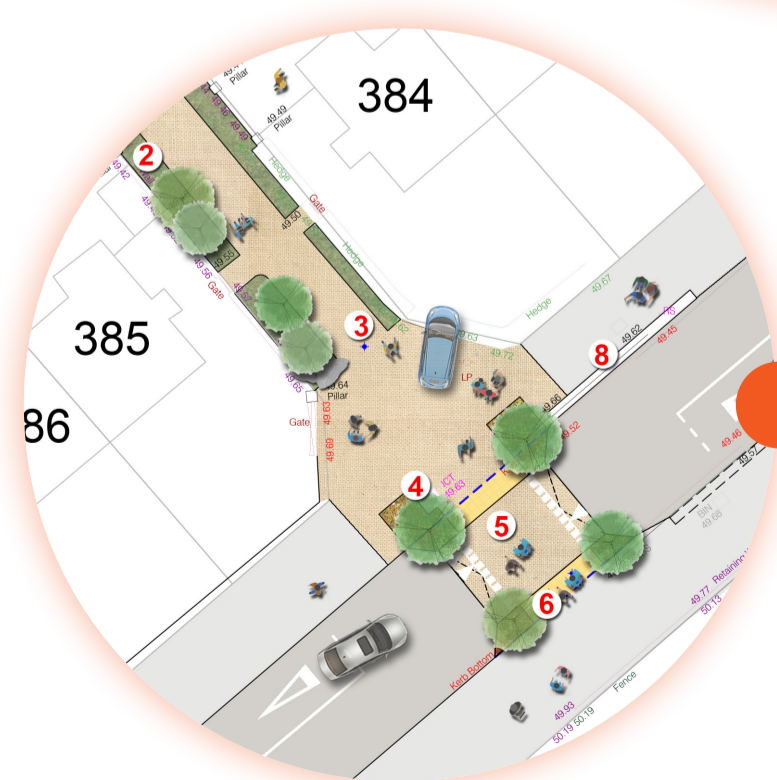

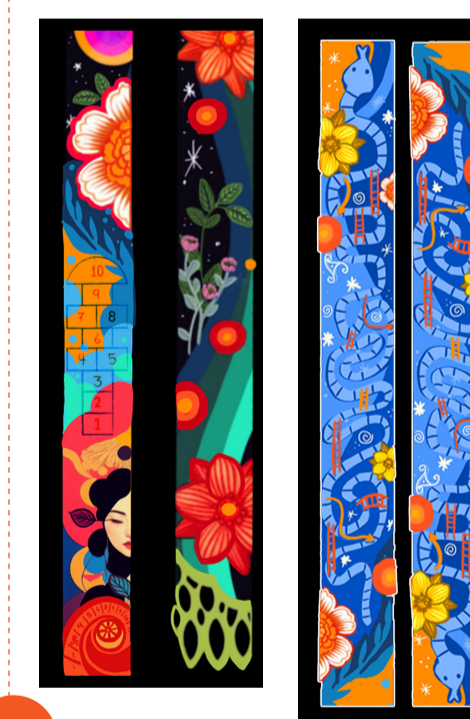

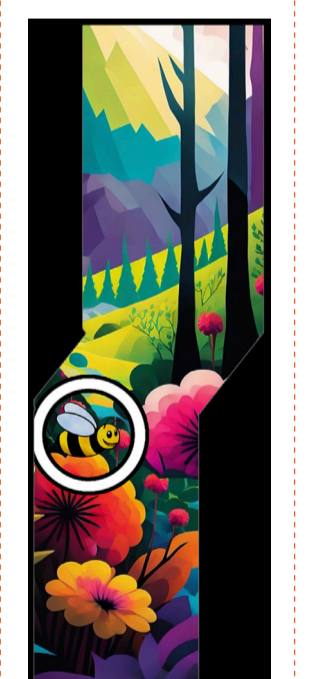
