

How to Play

Access

- To download the game to your mobile phone device scan the QR code in this booklet or search for Fernhill Park Experience on the app store.
- Open the application to begin the game.
- You will then be instructed to scan the tracking image to activate the augmented reality experience. You will find the tracking image on the back of this sheet. Lie the image out on a flat surface to play.



Game Instructions

- The game is divided into four sections.
- The introduction to the game begins with an audio piece on the history of Fernhill. You will then set out to explore your options.
- Use the slider to increase levels of renewable energy, reforestation and rewilding on the park.



- Each slider is divided into three sections. Move the slider into the different sections for new hotspots to appear. Click on the hotspot icons to find out what impact has been made.



- For each section you explore you will be awarded a badge.



- Once you collect all nine of the badges you will enter a decision-making stage with three sliders appearing. Here you will decide what future you want to create for Fernhill

- When you have chosen a final decision you will be then transported to the year 2075 where you will read about the future you have created.

Project Introduction

The Fernhill Park Experience is an interactive, educational, augmented reality (AR) game based on the new Fernhill Park and Gardens. The project is led by Dún Laoghaire Institute of Art, Design and Technology (IADT), in partnership with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council (DLRCC) and has been funded by the Science Foundation of Ireland (SFI).

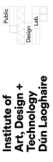
You will learn about the impacts of these changes, and you will then make a final important decision that will impact the future of Fernhill. You will then stretch into the future to read about what impact you have made.
