## DUN LAOGHAIRE HARBOUR NOTICE TO MARINERS

## USE OF UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAVs) / DRONES

Date: 01 January 2024

Unregulated and careless drone use, in and around the Harbour area, carries many potential hazards including risk of injury to Harbour staff and members of the public.

Consequently, the routine use of drones, or unmanned aerial vehicles of any type, is prohibited within the Harbour limits without prior written permission.

On occasions when professional operators request permission to use a drone for filming or survey work, the permission must be requested in writing, or by email to <a href="mailto:harbourmaster@dlrcoco.ie">harbourmaster@dlrcoco.ie</a>

The permission request must show evidence of IAA registration and sufficient, valid, Public Liability Insurance cover and, in any event, the operator must comply with the relevant requirements of the Data Protection Act.

A condition of the permission will be that the drone maintains a minimum distance of at least 30 metres from any person, vessel, quay, structure or vehicle.

Drones operated by the Emergency Services are exempt from these requirements, but the Harbour should be advised of any such operation, in advance if possible.
