
Enriches soils and ground floor canopies

We need volunteers to help plant 1500 native Irish woodland trees at Cluny Park.

You can make a lasting impression in your local community for generations. Encourage neighbours, friends and family to join us. We recommend you bring warm clothes, sturdy shoes, gloves, a garden trowel and some water and snacks

The trees will be very young native trees, densely planted and comprised of species such as Oak, Birch, Alder, Spindle, Hawthorn, Hazel, providing habitat for birds and pollinators, improving air quality and enriching the natural environment.


