PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 Temporary Closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities that proposes the temporary closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey from its junction with Castle Park Road to its junction with Hyde Road from **Monday**, **15**th **April 2024** to **Thursday**, **18**th **April 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is for <u>Uisce Éireann service and for water</u> connection to be connected.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 Temporary Closure of Carmanhall Road, Sandyford

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Kavanagh Crane Hire Ltd. that proposes a new amended date for the temporary closure of Carmanhall Road, Sandyford from its junction with Ballymoss Road to its junction with Ravens Rock Road on **Saturday**, **6**th **April 2024** between **06:00** hours to **14:00** hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to replace/repair telecom units.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNDALE ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Ward and Burke Construction that proposes to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Thornhill Road / Old Connaught Avenue junction to Allies River Road junction from **Monday**, **22**nd **April 2024** to **Friday**, **21**st **June 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is <u>installation of Ferndale Road culvert</u> <u>replacement</u> for Uisce Éireann.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd. to extend the temporary closure of Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout to **Tuesday**, **7**th **May 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic. The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other division routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted. The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is <u>full road reconstruction works</u> will require the road to be excavated and associated ancillary works on footpath.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 Temporary Closure of N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange Southbound and Northbound

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone, Fortunestown, Belgard, Tallaght, Dublin 24 to temporarily close part of the N11 Stillorgan Road between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound from **Monday**, **22**nd **January 2024** to **Sunday**, **30**th **June 2024** between 19:30 hours to 05:00 hours each day.

The start time of 19:30hrs is required as it allows the Contractor sufficient time to carry out the section of the works that creates the most noise i.e. the planing of the existing road surface.

It is a requirement that this section of the works is completed by 23:00hrs, therefore commencing the works at a time past 19:30hrs would serve to severely limit production and have a detrimental effect of the programme of the overall works.

An earlier time than 19:30hrs would assist with the programme but the effect on traffic movements would not be manageable, as such it is seen that a 19:30hrs start time provides the best approach in balancing both traffic movements and ensuring progress of the works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, local access and access for bus and emergency services will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to allow for realignment of the traffic lanes.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 Temporary Closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities that proposes the temporary closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck at the anchorage section of the one-way system onto the R825 on **Friday**, **22**nd **March 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to carry out <u>site investigation works</u> on behalf of the ESB. GMC would like to locate a joint bay for an electric cable.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 Temporary Closure of Stepaside Lane, Stepaside

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved a Temporary Road Closure application from Gas Networks Ireland, GMC House, Millenium Business Park, Cappagh Road, Dublin 11 proposing to temporarily close Stepaside Lane, Stepaside from its junction with Enniskerry Road to its junction with Burrow Road from Tuesday, 2nd April 2024 to Friday, 5th April 2024 between 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is gas works and reinstatement.

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2024 on the N11 Roadway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Southbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Northbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2024 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 22/01/2024 until 30/06/2024

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

 Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound.

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 60km/hr on the N11 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Roads Traffic Act, 2004.

Accordingly, I recommend the introduction of the 60km/hr speed limit (N11 Southbound and Northbound) from Monday, 22nd January 2024 until <u>Sunday</u>, 30th <u>June 2024</u> or for the duration of the works, whichever is the earlier.

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are undertaking the laying of water mains and rehab works at this location.

Works will continue until Friday, 5th April 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

R119 Dublin Road (opposite Allie's River Road on the N11 South of Shankill) **

Installation of a new signalized junction and right turning lane commenced on Wednesday, 6th March 2024 until Friday, <u>31st May 2024</u> between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 2-Way Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Lehaunstown Lane **

Clonmel Enterprises, working on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, are undertaking civil works as part of the Druid Glen Road Construction on Monday, 19^{th} February 2024 until Friday, $\underline{28^{th}}$ June 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

Rock Road, Blackrock **

Public lighting works, to replace existing underground cabling, commenced on Monday, 21st August 2023 and will continue until <u>July 2024</u> between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Stillorgan Park Road - from N11 to Carysfort Avenue, Blackrock ***

Junction buildouts, new kerbing, drainage, traffic signal ducting and all associated works to construct pedestrian and cyclist improvement scheme began on Tuesday, 6th February 2024 until <u>December 2024</u> between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme ***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme ***

Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, are working to provide a two-way cycle track on the western side of Deansgrange Road. The works will also upgrade pedestrian and cyclist's facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road.

There will be <u>no northbound access</u> to Deansgrange Road from Clonkeen Road / Kill Lane until at least **Monday, 15th April 2024**

Southbound access will remain open via a new temporary one-way system south of St. Fintan's Villas. Diversion signs will be in place. Traffic management measures will be in place along Deansgrange Road to facilitate the works.

The 84 and 84A northbound bus services will be diverted via Abbey Road for the duration of the works. The southbound bus route remains the same.

Glenageary Road Upper - Active Travel Scheme ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of two-way cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

Local access will be maintained at all times.

Glenageary Road Upper: Lane closure: 24-hours (road milling and resurfacing) - **Tuesday**, **2**th **April 2024 until Friday**, **5**th **April 2024.**
