

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Roadstone Ltd. that proposes the temporary closure of Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 29th July 2024** to **Monday, 30th September 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic. The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other diversion routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted. The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is road resurfacing works will require the final layer of asphalt and minor civil works including ironworks, line marking and installation of defender kerbs.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd. to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's pharmacy from **Saturday, 24th August 2024** until **Sunday, 25th August 2024** from 11:00 hours to 19:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to create a safe and family friendly community atmosphere for the Lobster Festival with cookery demonstrations, street entertainment etc.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of (1) M50 Southbound between Junction 14 and Junction 15, (2) M/N11 merge onto M50 Southbound, (3) M50 Southbound between Junction 15 and Junction 16

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Swarco UK & Ireland Ltd. to temporarily close (1) M50 Southbound between Junction 14 and Junction 15, (2) M/N11 merge onto M50 Southbound, (3) M50 Southbound between Junction 15 and Junction 16. The closure will run from **Monday, 15th July 2024** to **Wednesday, 17th July 2024** between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours each night.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the installation of CCTV poles on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NUTGROVE PARK, ROEBUCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities that proposes the temporary closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck from its junction with Leinster Lawn to its junction with Clonskeagh Road from **Wednesday, 10th July 2024** to **Friday, 19th July 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the installation of a new joint box on the existing 110kv ESB line going through Nutgrove Park.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Brennanstown Road

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application for the temporary road closure of Brennanstown Road from its junction with Brighton Road to its junction with Cabinteely Village crossroads (Garda Station) from **Monday, 15th July 2024** to **Friday, 6th September 2024** between the times of 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for road reconstruction and resurfacing and footpath resurfacing.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Newtownpark Avenue between Granville Road and Whites Cross, Blackrock *****

(Night works)

Gas Networks Ireland are replacing valves on existing Gas Mains located in the carriageway. These works will commence on Monday, 8th July 2024 until Friday, 26th July 2024.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place – 24/7.

» **Park Avenue, Newpark ****

Replace pole in front of house on Park Avenue.

Works will commence on Monday, 8th July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Springhill Avenue, Deansgrange ****

Replace pole in front of house on Springhill Avenue, in sidewalk.
Minor works on nearby poles.

Works will commence on Friday, 12th July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Frankfort / Rosemount Junction, Dundrum Road ****

Construction of signalised junction will commence on Monday, 8th July 2024 until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 4-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Deerpark Entrance, North Avenue, Mount Merrion **

Improvement works to the Deerpark entrance on North Avenue will continue until Friday 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Pearse Drive, Sallynoggin **

Footpath and road improvements will continue until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Stillorgan Village, Blackrock **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out rehab works to the water and sewer network programme at this location. Works will continue until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Church Road, Killiney **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location. Works will commence on Monday, 8th July 2024 for one day between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Harbour Road and Breffni Road **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Some extra hours are possible.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackthorn Road **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Northumberland Avenue **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works commenced on Monday, 1st July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours for a period of 6-8 weeks.

Some extra hours are possible.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme ***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme **

Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, are upgrading pedestrian and cycling facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road. The scheme is now substantially complete, but some minor snagging works may take place during July. The works will have a low impact on traffic.

Glenageary Road Upper – Active Travel Scheme ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned an Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of two-way cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

Local access will be maintained at all times.
