SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ROADS WITHIN THE SANDYFORD BUSINESS DISTRICT TO FACILITATE THE SANDYFORD 5K

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Dundrum South Dublin Athletic Club, in association with Sandyford Business District Association, for partial to full closure of a number of roads within Sandyford Business District on Thursday 8th May 2025, to facilitate the 2025 Sandyford 5K.
