PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAMUCK ROAD, CARRICKMINES

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from BAM Civil Limited that proposes the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Brambledown housing estate to its junction with Enniskerry Road (Golden Ball T-junction) from **Friday, 30th May 2025**.
