### SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF R138 STILLORGAN ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application to temporarily close R138/Stillorgan Road from Foster's Avenue to Belfield Bridge on **Sunday, 1<sup>st</sup> June 2025** from 11:30 hours to 16:00 hours in order to facilitate the running of the **VHI Women's Mini Marathon**.

The diversion route is via Foster's Avenue and Roebuck Road.
