PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GEORGE'S PLACE, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Kavco Carpentry & Construction Ltd. that proposes to temporarily close George's Place, Dún Laoghaire from its junction with Clarence Street to its junction with Callaghan's Lane on **Thursday**, **25th September 2025** between 07:00 hours and 19:00 hours. An alternative date of **Friday**, **26th September 2025** between 07:00 hours and 19:00 hours will be used instead, in the event that adverse weather conditions cause cancellation of works on the original date.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the dismantling of a tower crane.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD, GLENAGEARY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Irish Rail for the temporary closure of Station Road, Glenageary from its junction with Adelaide Road to its junction with Marlborough Road in order to accommodate nightworks. The periods of closure are as follows;

- 22:00 hours on Friday 12th of September, 2025 to 06:00 hours on Saturday 13th of September, 2025.
- 22:00 hours on Saturday 13th of September, 2025 to 08:00 hours on Sunday 14th of September, 2025.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for Irish Rail to renew the metal parapets of OBR102 Glenageary Station Footbridge. Irish Rail intend to set up and operate a mobile crane on Station Road to undertake this work.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAMUCK ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council had approved an application from BAM Civil Limited for the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Brambledown housing estate to its junction with Enniskerry Road (Golden Ball T-junction) from Friday, 30th May 2025. The closure was deferred, but subsequently commenced from **Thursday**, 19th June 2025.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

A bus gate will be in place following completion of the road closure, in compliance with granted planning under Section 51 of the Roads Act 1993, which will prohibit through vehicular traffic other than buses.

Glenamuck District Roads Scheme ***

The Glenamuck District Distributor Road (GDDR), linking Carrickmines Retail Park to De La Salle Palmerston Rugby Club on the Enniskerry Road, opened to traffic on Thursday, 19th June 2025.

Following the opening of GDDR, a road closure will be implemented on Glenamuck Road. A Traffic Management Plan will be in place to support both the road opening and associated road closure.

Cumberland Street: Living Streets Dún Laoghaire Phase 1, Active Travel Scheme ***

Living Streets Dún Laoghaire project is a mobility and public realm improvement project which aims to enhance the attractiveness, liveability, connectivity, and economic vibrancy of Dún Laoghaire Town.

The site of the proposed works under Phase 1 are undertaken in multiple phases across different locations in Dún Laoghaire including Cumberland Street, Clarence Street, York Road, George's Street Lower, Library Road, Lynch Lane, and Glenageary Wood.

Clonmel Enterprises working on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council commenced works on the Cumberland Street phase on Thursday, 19th June 2025 which will last approximately <u>8-weeks</u>. The works will include new footpaths, kerbs, traffic signals, drainage/ducting adjustments, and landscaping.

The permitted working hours are from 10:00 to 16:00 hours, Monday to Friday.

The works will encompass Cumberland Street from its junction with York Road to its junction with De Vesci Terrace.

Intermittent Stop/Go Traffic Management will be in place, if required, between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Glenageary Road Upper, Kill Avenue, Mounttown Road Lower, Oliver Plunkett Road

Ongoing works at Honeypark Junction will impact traffic flows along all approaches - Kill Avenue, Oliver Plunkett Road, Mounttown Road Lower, Glenageary Road Lower, Highthorn Road. This phase of the works will last until November 2025.

The entrance to Claremount Avenue from Kill Avenue will remain closed for the duration of this work phase. The bus stop opposite Claremount Ave will be temporarily relocated further up Kill Ave.

Library Road - Living Streets Dún Laoghaire Phase 1, Active Travel Scheme ***
