#### PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

## SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF REDGREY COURT, FARRENBOLEY PARK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Gas Networks Ireland to temporarily close Redgrey Court, Farrenboley Park from Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 to Wednesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate a gas connection to a new development on Dundrum Road.

Any interested parties may lodge objections/observations in writing to the Senior Engineer, County Hall, Marine road, Dun Laoghaire on or before Noon on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

### **ROAD CLOSURES**

### SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNDALE ROAD

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Old Connaught Avenue to Thornhill Road junction from Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> October 2022 to Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new section of pipe for Irish Water as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract along Ferndale Road.

# SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADWAYS TO FACILITATE THE DUBLIN CITY MARATHON 2022.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close the following roads within the Council's Administrative area:-

- 1. Clonskeagh Road
- 2. Roebuck Road
- 3. Foster's Avenue
- 4. Stillorgan Road (R138 Dual Carriageway), North from junction with Foster's Avenue and via the UCD Flyover to the County Boundary.

The purpose of the closures is to facilitate the running of the Irish Life Dublin City Marathon on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

Manning of the Road Closures and the diversion of Traffic will be under the Control of the Gardaí and race organisers and diversions will be clearly signposted. Local access will be maintained as far as possible.

# SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCHTOWN ROAD LOWER, DUBLIN 14

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Churchtown Road Lower, Dublin 14, from the junction of Orwell Road to the junction of Churchtown Road Upper from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2022 to Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the undertaking of road surfacing works to be carried out by Actavo (Ireland) Limited on behalf of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council Traffic Section.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

### SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN ROAD

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Ballyman Road from Thornhill Road junction to Monastery Road from Monday,  $10^{\rm th}$  October 2022 to Friday,  $4^{\rm th}$  November 2022.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to ensure safe access to sites for the construction of reservoir sites as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook Contract.

### SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kilternan from Murphy's Lane junction to Ballyman Road junction from Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in operation. Local and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to ensure safe access to sites for the construction of reservoir sites as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook Contract.

## SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACKGLEN ROAD, SANDYFORD, DUBLIN 18

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Blackglen Road between the two junctions with Ticknock Park and Simonsridge from Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022 to Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

A number of submissions were received in relation to the proposed road closure. These submissions have been considered and the road closure is approved with amended dates, and mitigation measures in place. The road closure will be in place from Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to Friday, 04<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate road works as part of the Blackglen Road improvement scheme.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The proposed diversion route will be via the Loop road and all residents access will be maintained.

A traffic management plan will be in place and the diversion will be clearly signposted.

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HILLCREST ROAD, SANDYFORD, DUBLIN 18**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close HILLCREST Road between junctions at Sandyford Road and Sandyford Village.

The road closure will be in place from Monday, 24th October 2022 to Friday, 04<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate road works as part of the Blackglen Road improvement scheme.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The proposed diversion route will be via the Sandyford Village and Sandyford Road. All residents access will be maintained.

A traffic management plan will be in place and the diversion will be clearly signposted.

#### **SPEED LIMIT ORDER**

## Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the <u>M50 Motorway</u> in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the M50 Traffic Flow Optimisation Construction Project; has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

M50 Southbound will run from 7<sup>th</sup> February 2022 until 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 Overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 Overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South
  of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
  taper
  (Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South
  of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge
  taper
  (Total 575m in length).

### M50 Northbound will run from 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021 until 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

### Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to **80 km/hr** on the M50 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

#### »Brehon Field Road\*\*\*\*

Road surfacing works on Brehon Field Road commences Monday  $24^{th}$  October 2022 . Works will commence between 10am and 4pm Daily for 2 weeks

A traffic management plan will be in operation and VMS Sign are in place . The Slip Lane from the M50 on to Brehon Field Road ( Junction 13 Southbound ) will be close for 3 days for Works to accommodate these works from Monday  $24^{th}$  Oct 2022 at 10am

### » Cross Avenue, Northcote Avenue & Northcote Place\*\*

### »Dun Laoghaire, Junction of St Marys Street and St Brendan's Terrace \*\*

### **#Churchtown Road Lower \*\*\***
