

Aluminium Cans - Drink cans	Liquids, food stuffs

## Free of charge

YES	EXAMPLES
Kitchen Appliances	Washing machines, cookers, microwaves, fridge, freezers
Light Bulbs	Flourescent tubes, long life and filament bulbs
Batteries	Car batteries, mobile phone batteries, household batteries
Gas Cylinders	Place all cylinders upright (domestic type only)
Fire Extinguishers	Must be discharged (domestic type only)
Waste Oils	Cooking oil, motor oil. No Petrol, Heating Oil or Diesel
Electronic and Electrical Waste	Computers, monitors, printers, scanners, TVs, VCRs, CD/DVD players, stereos, electrical tools
Metals	Bicycles, scrap metal, radiators, petrol lawn mowers
Sheet/Plate Glass	Windscreens, mirrors, stained glass, patterned glass, wired glass, double glazing (no frames). No Ceramics



## **Chargeable Items**

YES	EXAMPLES
Wood	Garden timber, hardwood flooring, doors, softwood
Bulky items	Furniture, carpets, beds, sofas
General Waste	Domestic refuse, plant pots, potting trays, small household items that would fit in a wheelie bin.  No food waste or tyres
Soil, Stones and Household Construction and Demolition Waste	Bricks, paving slabs, concrete, soil, rocks, blocks. No asbestos
Gysum/Plasterboard	Dedicated skip provided
Green Garden Waste	Grass, hedge cuttings, leaves
Household Hazardous Waste	Paints, thinners, strippers, cleaning agents, detergents, bleaches, insecticides, glues and medicines. All household hazardous waste must be in clearly labelled containers



## **Vehicle Charging Structure**

#### Applicable to any or all of the following:

Wood, Bulky Items, General Waste, Soil, Stones and Household Construction & Demolition Waste with or without Green Garden Waste included.

No food waste.

#### CATEGORY AND ACCEPTABLE VEHICLE TYPES

#### Category 1 - Charge €30

Cars, MPVs, Estate Cars, People Carriers, Rear Passenger Seat Jeep or 4x4 Type Vehicles.

#### Category 2- Charge €60

Small Vans, Car Vans (see note 1)

Small Trailer carrying up to 1.5 m³ (see note 2)

Non Rear Passenger Seat Jeep/MPV/4x4 Type Vehicles.

#### Category 3 - Charge €100

Intermediate Vans (see note 1)

Intermediate Trailers carrying up to 3 m<sup>3</sup> (see note 2)

Household Hazardous Waste - Charge €5

#### COMMENT

Waste delivered by:

Pedestrian, Bicycle or Motorbike is charged as a Category 1 waste.

Vehicles larger than Intermediate Vans (e.g. Transit Vans), are not permitted except when delivering bulky items only.

If delivered with other non chargeable waste.

### **Vehicle Charging Structure**

Applicable to: Green Garden Waste only.

CATEGORY AND ACCEPTABLE VEHICLE TYPES	COMMENT
Category 4 – Charge €8  Cars, MPVs, Estate Cars, People Carriers, Rear  Passenger seat Jeep or 4x4 Type Vehicles.	Green Garden Waste delivered by: Pedestrian, Bicycle or Motorbike is charged as a Category 4 waste.
Category 5 – Charge €25  Small Vans, Car Vans (see note 1)  Small Trailer carrying up to 1.5 m³ (see note 2)  Non Rear Passenger Seat Jeep/MPV/4x4  Type Vehicles.	
Category 6 – Charge €50  Intermediate Vans (see note 1) Intermediate Trailers carrying up to 3 m³ (see note 2)	Vehicles larger than Intermediate Vans (eg. Transit Vans), are not permitted.

#### Note 1

Vans are classified in accordance with the "Van Classification Guidance" document which is available for inspection at the facility.

#### Note 2

Trailer category is based upon a best estimation of the gross volume of material being carried and not the volume of the trailer itself.

#### Note 3

Vehicles and trailers are charged separately.

#### Note 4

Waste carried on the roof of vehicles will be subject to trailer rules.

## **Recycling responsibly**

- Recyclables should be as clean and dry as possible
- Rinse out all remaining food and liquids
- Flatten or squash boxes, cartons and cans
- Remove plastic packaging from cardboard and paper
- Check that your plastic containers are recyclable, plastic bottle tops can be left on
- Make sure you put the correct material in each container

Only household waste will be accepted at the facility

The facility is for the use of private vehicles only

No commercial waste will be accepted on site in compliance with EPA Licence No. woo15-01





# General notes for customers using Ballyogan Recycling Park

Credit card payments are accepted at Ballyogan Recycling Park. You can also pay by cash and laser / debit card.

Customers should for their own convenience pack waste into their vehicles, segregated by material type, so that it can be quickly unloaded.

Customers must secure and cover waste carried in trailers or on roof racks.

Ballyogan Recycling Park is located in a residential area. Please be considerate to our neighbours when accessing the site.

Do not sound car horns unless absolutely necessary, do not block entrances or cause obstruction to other users of the public roads.
